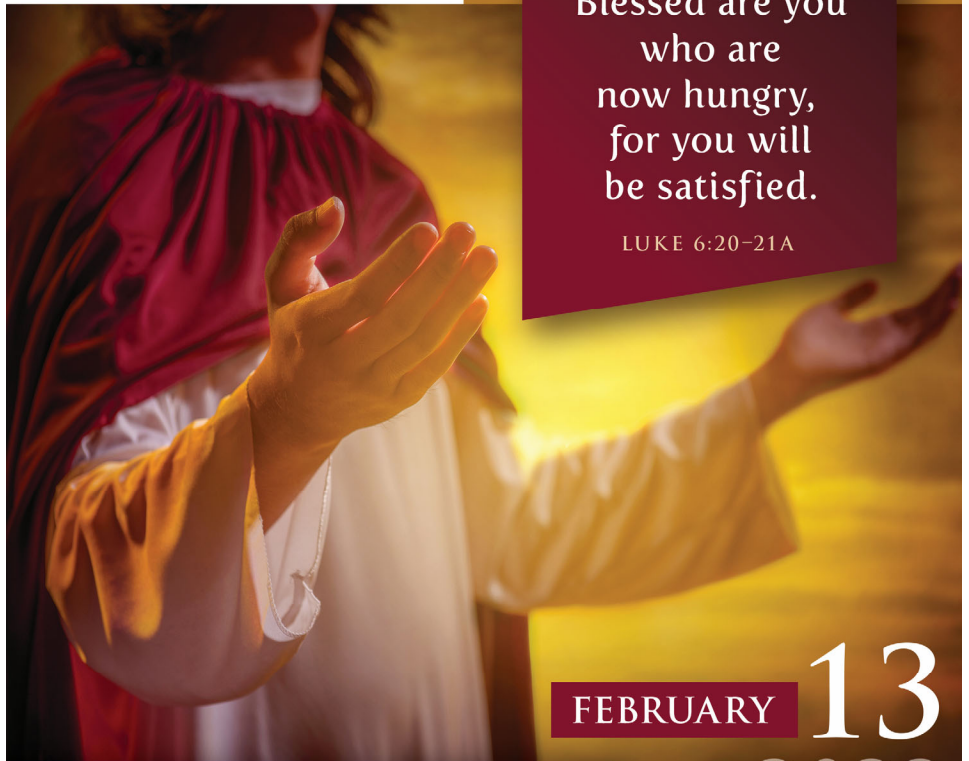

Dear Parishioners,

Today we observe World Marriage Day. Sacramental Marriage in the Church brings with it many graces to meet the challenges married couples face in our world today. Let us pray for all those married or who are contemplating marriage in the Church!

I offer a final report on our Christmas collection. Totals are:

2021 - \$50,534.11 2020 - \$55,797.50 2019 - \$62,384.08

The number of families continues to grow for the Annual Appeal. Pledges and gifts now total \$25,850.66, which is 29% of our parish goal of \$104,591.00. Most of you should have received a brochure and pledge envelope in the mail, and may return it directly to the Archdiocese. We will continue to accept pledge envelopes in the Sunday collection throughout the next 5 months. Remember that if our total pledges meet the goal before June 30 and then the payments are completed by December, our parish will receive any amount over the goal.

We will be conducting our Synod survey in church on the last weekend of this month, and an open forum in Conlon Hall later in March. We will explain what we will be doing for the church survey in next weekend's bulletin. In the meantime, continue to pray the Synod prayer each day.

Reflection on Today's Scripture Readings

One of the memorable scenes in an English novel of some years ago describes a little boy named Bron going to church for the first time with his governess. He watches with interest every part of the service. The preacher then climbs into the high pulpit and Bron hears him deliver a piece of terrible news about a brave and kind man who a long time ago was viciously ill-treated, nailed to a cross, and who feels a dreadful pain even now because there is so much that needs to be done in accordance with his teaching. Little Bron thinks the preacher is telling the story so the people in the pews will rise up and take up the cause.

The service ends and to Bron's shock and surprise the people walk away as if they had not heard such terrible news, as if there was nothing that demanded their attention. Bron is crying as he leaves the church, and when the governess discovers the reason, she says: "You shouldn't have taken all that the preacher said to heart. Quit your crying, people are going to think you strange!"

The story gives us pause to consider how often we fail to do the right thing, how we hold back honest and rightful emotions, how we keep silent when a prejudice is stated, how we say nothing in the face of an injustice, all because we don't wish to be thought strange. —Rev. Reflexión de las Escrituras de Hoy

Una de las escenas más memorables de una novela británica de hace unos años describe a un pequeño niño llamado Bron yendo a la iglesia por primera vez con su institutriz. El niño observa con interés cada parte de la celebración. El predicador sube al púlpito y Bron escucha una terrible noticia acerca de un hombre valiente y bondadoso, quien hacía tiempo había sido maltratado, crucificado y que aún hoy sigue sufriendo espantosamente porque hay mucho que se necesita hacer según sus enseñanzas. El pequeño Bron piensa que el predicador cuenta la historia para que la gente en las bancas se amotine y luchen por la causa.

Al terminarse la celebración Bron está turbado y sorprendido de que la gente sale como si nada, como si no hubieran escuchado unas noticias tan terribles, como si no hubiese nada que exigiera su atención. Al salir de la iglesia Bron está llorando y cuando la institutriz descubre la razón por la que llora le dice: “No debiste tomar a pecho lo que dijo el predicador. ¡Deja de llorar, que la gente se va a creer que eres extraño!”

Esta historia nos hace detenernos a considerar cuán a menudo dejamos de hacer lo correcto; las veces que reprimimos nuestras emociones justas y honestas; cómo guardamos silencio cuando oímos prejuicios; cómo nos quedamos callados frente a las injusticias. 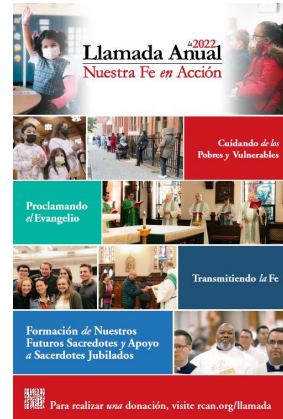


Oración por el Sínodo

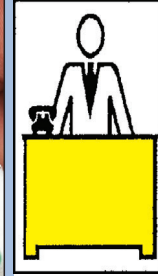
