Reflection on Today's Scripture Readings

I went back to the old neighborhood a while ago and realized there what everyone who has ever tried to go home discovers. The trees have grown smaller and easier for climbing, the alley where we played hide-and-go-seek has grown narrower, the trip to the corner less daring, and all the old haunts so much less intriguing. But going back also drew forth in me a power I had not imagined or expected. Not only did it reintroduce me to who I am, it renewed the dream of who I could be. Going back to one's roots can do that because it's a going back to where it all began.

Lent can be such a time of returning to our roots. Some would see the season as penitential, a time of reparation for sin; others as a time for growing more prayerful or for reestablishing lives of service or for deepening faith. And it can be all of that. Yet the readings of this Lenten Sunday take us back to how it once was and who was once doing the shaping of life.

There are myriad ways of making the Lenten journey back to our roots. Spend time with the scriptures. Read the lives of the saints. Go on a retreat. Visit a shrine. Keep a journal. Pray the rosary again. Sit with silence. Make the Stations of the Cross. Offer peace to an enemy. Visit the sick or a shut-in. Give enough alms to notice the pinch. Do some spiritual reading. Fast and abstain from meat. They are all part of our tradition and shards of our own pasts. In them we will once more meet ourselves, perhaps as if for the first time, and remember dreams long lost in the clutter of life's demands. —Rev. Joseph J. Hace poco tiempo regresé a mi antigua vecindad y caí en cuenta de algo que todos los que han vuelto a su lugar de origen descubren. Los árboles son más pequeños y parecen más fáciles de subir, el callejón donde jugábamos a las escondidas se ha vuelto más estrecho, caminar a la esquina es menos atrevido y todas las demás cosas que frecuentábamos son mucho menos intrigantes. Pero volver allí también me dio una energía que no me había imaginado ni esperado. No sólo me puso en contacto de nuevo con mi propia identidad, sino que también renovó el sueño de quién podría yo llegar a ser. Regresar a nuestras raíces puede lograr eso, porque nos lleva hacia donde todo comenzó.

La Cuaresma bien puede ser ese tiempo de volver a nuestras raíces. Algunos considerarán este tiempo como penitencial, un tiempo para la expiación de nuestros pecados; otros lo verán como un tiempo para darnos más a la oración o restablecer nuestras obras de servicio, o para profundizar en la fe. Todo eso es parte de nuestra tradición y fragmentos de nuestro propio pasado. En esas acciones volveremos a encontrarnos con nosotros mismos, tal vez como por primera vez, y recordaremos sueños que se nos habían perdido en medio de los abarrotos y las exigencias de la vida. —Padre Joseph J. IN THE DESERT

Jesus was led by the Spirit into the desert for forty days, and then the devil tested him. Moses and the Israelites had been in the desert for forty years before being led to the land of milk and honey. There were times when they called out to God, sure that, as Saint Paul wrote to the Romans, “everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.” We sometimes spend time in the desert as well. Not a literal desert most of the time, but a desert in which it seems difficult to perceive God’s presence, times when we face difficulty and are tempted to leave God’s ways behind. On this First Sunday of Lent, Jesus shows us what to do in these moments: stand firm and trust in God.

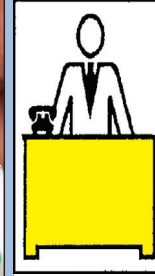
