Reflection on Today's Scripture Readings

Every so often life gives you a glimpse of glory: a moment of beauty in a sunset, of goodness in a person, of truth in words spoken, of peace and well-being. Sometimes it comes suddenly; other times it's been there all along but you haven't been paying much attention. But it is real and you know it is a glimpse of glory.

This is what happened to Peter, James, and John. Jesus often went off to pray during their time with him, traveling through towns and villages. Luke makes a special point of telling us this more than once. At these times he would experience the presence of his Father. Now, while he is praying with his friends, the Father again draws near, not just to Jesus this time but to his disciples, too.

But first there are Moses and Elijah, also in a state of glory, speaking to Jesus about his coming death, his "exodus," his passing over into glory. And Jesus will go on to speak to his disciples about his coming death, which they will not want to hear. But for now they are given a glimpse of glory, of what is at the end of the road.

Every so often we need a reminder of what we are destined for, that our citizenship is in heaven. We need to be reminded of the promise that our Savior will come and "change our lowly body to conform with his glorified body" (Philippians 3:21). Reflexión de las Escrituras de Hoy

De vez en cuando la vida te ofrece un vislumbre de la gloria: un momento en que aprecias la belleza de una puesta del sol, la bondad de una persona, la verdad expresada en palabras, la paz y el bienestar. A veces esos momentos vienen de súbito; otras veces han estado ahí todo el tiempo, pero no has estado prestando mucha atención. Pero son muy reales y tú los reconoces como vislumbres de la gloria.

Eso fue lo que le pasó a Pedro, Santiago y Juan. Jesús se retiraba a menudo a orar cuando estaba con ellos y yendo de pueblo en pueblo. Lucas nos recalca esto de una manera especial y más de una vez. En esos momentos Jesús experimentaba la presencia de su Padre. Ahora, mientras ora con sus amigos, el Padre se acerca de nuevo, y esta vez no sólo a Jesús sino también a los discípulos.

Pero primero encontramos ahí, en un estado de gloria, a Moisés y a Elías, que hablan con Jesús acerca de la aproximación de su muerte, el “éxodo” de Jesús y su paso hacia la gloria. Más tarde Jesús les hablará a los discípulos de la cercanía de su muerte, lo cual ellos no querían oír. Pero por ahora reciben un vislumbre de la gloria que está al final del camino.

De vez en cuando necesitamos que se nos recuerde cuál es nuestro destino y que nuestra ciudadanía está en el cielo. Necesitamos que nos recuerden la promesa de nuestro Salvador de que “él transformará nuestro frágil cuerpo en un cuerpo glorioso como el suyo” (Filipenses 3:21). 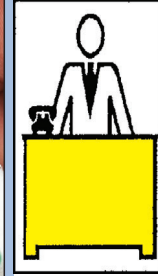
