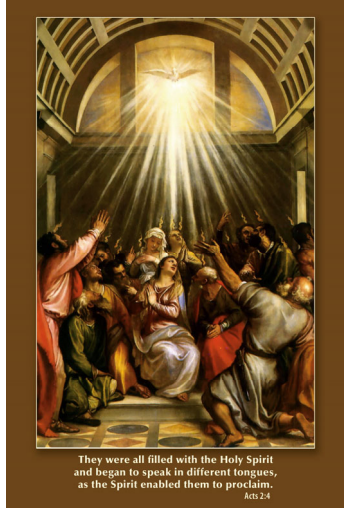

## *Pastor's Desk*

Dear Parishioners,

Today we celebrate Pentecost, considered the birthday of the Church, when the Holy Spirit came down on the Apostles and enabled them to speak in various languages about the death and resurrection of Jesus. Thousands were added to the fledgling Church that day. Let us pray that the Holy Spirit may continue to inspire us to share our faith in Jesus with others, that the Catholic Church may continue to grow both locally and around the world!

Thank you to all who helped in the liturgies and receptions of new priests Ashton Wong and Matthew Gonzalez last weekend. They are both grateful for your support and ask for your continued prayers as they start their ministry. **I especially want to share with you the GOOD NEWS that Cardinal Tobin has decided to assign Fr. Ashton as an additional priest to our parish staff, effective June 18th!** This will be a blessing for us, and is another reassurance by Cardinal Tobin about the vibrancy of our parish community and the excellent training our parish provides for new priests and deacons. Of course, I encourage your financial support of this extra expense to our parish budget of around \$54,000.00, by your faithful giving or increase in the weekly collection and unified cooperation in all our parish fundraisers. Fr. Matthew Gonzalez has also been reassigned to his former deacon parish, St. Bartholomew's in Scotch Plains.

I continue to rejoice that with the help of so many of you, we have not only surpassed our stretch goal of \$104,591.00 in pledges for the Annual Appeal, now at \$120,918.66, but payments have already gone over our goal, so we are currently guaranteed a rebate of \$2,625.00 next January, and if all the pledges are paid off before December 31<sup>st</sup>, we will receive back \$16,327.66. Any new pledges and their payments will only add to what will come back to us, so new pledges are still welcome! Thank you to all those who support both our parish and our archdiocese!

### *Reflection on Today's Scripture Readings*

In the Middle Ages, when science seemed to be stepsister to the arts, people thought that phlogiston was what made something burnable. The more phlogiston, the more readily flammable was the way they understood physics' inner workings. It explained why rocks did not burn and why straw readily did.

Though phlogiston has long been shelved, its theory is not so far removed from how the Spirit of God burns in our lives, nor is it far from the gifts that God's Spirit sets aflame in us. If some effort of ours glows with light and heat, it may be a sign of much Spirit, sort of like phlogiston. On the other hand, if in our effort to shine there's not even a spark, it's quite likely that that is not where the Spirit has settled into us. It might be better to pay attention then to some other aspect of life.

The struggle is to make sure that our imagined passion and where the Spirit of God wants us to be are one and the same so that the former does not cause us to stray from the latter. How does anyone know if they are where they should be? St. Paul says that the Spirit gives each of us our own dose of divine giftedness, our own spark with which to shine, but it's not given to us for our own glory or fun or feel-good self-image but for the good of others, for the community, for building up life. John's Gospel suggests one other such test—whether or not we're at peace. That, too, is the Spirit's gift. —Rev. Joseph J. Juknialis Copyright © 2012, World Library Publications. ### *Reflexión de las Escrituras de Hoy*

En la Edad Media la ciencia parecía más bien la hermanastra de las artes y la gente creía que el flogisto causaba combustión. Mientras más flogisto más combustible; así era como entendían la física. Eso explicaba por qué las rocas no se quemaban y la paja ardía inmediatamente.

Aunque ya el flogisto está en desuso desde hace tiempo su teoría no está lejos de cómo el Espíritu de Dios arde en nuestra vida y de cómo los dones del Espíritu de Dios inflaman nuestro propio espíritu. Si algún esfuerzo nuestro se ve resplandeciente pudiera ser un signo de mucho Espíritu, algo así como el flogisto. Por otro lado, si en nuestro esfuerzo por brillar ni siquiera brota una chispa, lo más probable es que en eso no esté el Espíritu. En este último caso sería mejor prestarle atención a algún otro aspecto de la vida.

Debemos hacer la lucha para asegurarnos de que nuestra imaginaria pasión y el lugar donde el Espíritu de Dios nos quiere es lo mismo, a fin de que lo primero no nos lleve a alejarnos de lo segundo. ¿Cómo se puede saber si uno está donde debe? San Pablo dice que el Espíritu da, a cada uno de nosotros, nuestra propia dosis de los dones divinos y nuestra propia chispa para que podamos iluminar, pero no se nos dan para nuestra propia gloria o disfrute, ni para sentirnos bien con nosotros mismos, sino para el bien de los demás y de la comunidad.
