Dear Parishioners,

As was announced last weekend, our PARISH CARNIVAL HAS BEEN POSTPONED TO AUGUST 23-27, due to the difficulty of the ride organizer to get sufficient workers in July. We have adapted the sign-up QR code and sheet to reflect the new dates. Please log in again or fill out a new form, so that we may have the accurate dates you will be able to volunteer for our booths.

However, since the date is imprinted on the tickets, our GIANT 50-50 RAFFLE will continue to be drawn on JULY 23<sup>rd</sup> at 10:30pm. Since we will not be able to have these raffle ticket sales at the carnival in August, your help with this raffle is needed more than ever to make it a success both for the winners and for the parish. Chance books are available from members of our Hispanic and Filipino apostolates, and weekdays at the rectory from 10am to 4pm, or arrange during those hours for pickup at another time. We will not be sending them through the mail.

Tomorrow, we celebrate our country's Independence Day. Our single Mass will be at 9:00am. This year we especially celebrate the right to life of children in the womb, as a result of the recent Supreme Court decision overturning Roe v Wade, which we would consider an answer to almost a half century of prayer. We do believe that human life begins from the moment of conception. Medical science has been able to dramatically show through ultrasound and other means how early that life is truly visible in the womb. While a woman may have a right to choose what to do with her body, once she has chosen to use her body to conceive her child, she now has the responsibility of protecting and nurturing that life, as the child cannot make his/her own choice for life but depends on the mother. Countless couples would love to have a child but cannot. Pregnancy resource centers which we support can help in giving unwanted babies a home. For those who have sadly chosen abortion, our Archdiocese provides Rachel's Vineyard weekends to help them find their way back to God.

### *Reflection on Today's Scripture Readings*

Robert Fulghum tells the story of a troubled man who paid a visit to his rabbi. He had experienced a great deal of failure in his life and didn't feel that he had what it takes to accomplish his dreams. After listening to the man's tale of woe, the rabbi instructed him to seek out page thirty of the *New York Times Almanac*. That would be of help.

Following that instruction, he found that the almanac entry was a list of the top hitters in the annals of baseball, with Ty Cobb leading the pack with a .376 batting average. Puzzled as to how that applied to his problem, he returned to the rabbi for an explanation. The rabbi explained that that page of Hall of Fame hitters represented people who in essence failed about seven out of every ten times at bat.

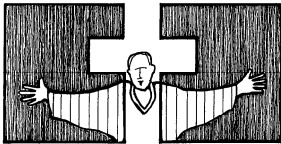

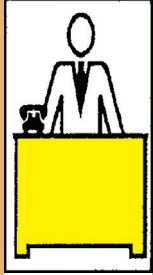
