Salesian Sisters Mission Appeal

As part of the Archdiocesan Mission Cooperation Plan, a Salesian Sister of St. John Bosco will speak at our Parish on the weekend of July 30/31 on behalf of their foreign mission ministries.

The Salesian Sisters are a worldwide Community counting about 12,000 Sisters spreading the Gospel on every Continent. Many of their Sisters work strictly in mission areas affected by great poverty, diseases, political unrest, violence, war & other difficult conditions, such as, areas of natural disaster & refugee camps.

The Salesian Sisters were founded by St. John Bosco in 1872 and started their mission work in 1877 when they departed from Italy for the farthest tip of South America called Patagonia & Tierra del Fuego. Ever since, they have continued to provide missionaries for Africa, Asia, Latin America, the Pacific Islands & other places not yet evangelized or in need of re-evangelization.

Their Congregation was specifically founded for the service of poor youth; consequently, most of their ministries will have an educational thrust. They are grateful for the opportunity of sharing their mission work here at St. John the Evangelist and of benefiting from your generosity in a special second collection.

Reflection on Today's Scripture Readings

Prayer has always been part of the Christian heritage. The book of Psalms long ago became the prayer book of the church, along with some hymns and canticles from other books of the Bible, both Old and New Testaments. Among the most beautiful prayers we have are the *Magnificat* of Mary, the *Benedictus* of Zechariah, and the *Nunc Dimittis* of Simeon, all in the Gospel of Luke (Luke 1:46–55; 1:68–79; 2:29–32).

Most importantly, Jesus prayed. Think about that for a moment. Jesus, the Son of God, the Word made flesh, the only begotten Son, prayed. We know that he went off by himself to pray. He did this before some of the most important moments in his ministry, like before he chose those who would be with him. But it is safe to assume that he did it as a habit.

So when one of the disciples asked him to teach them to pray and Jesus responded with the Our Father, it deserves our attention. This prayer reveals the heart of Jesus, and tells us how we should speak to the Father. The prayer has two parts: blessing the Father and calling for his presence in the world, then turning to God for our basic needs of food, forgiveness, and fidelity.

The parables that follow call us to persevere and persist in prayer because God is a Father who will give us his life-blood, in this case, the Holy Spirit, to all who ask. Reflexión de las Escrituras de Hoy

La oración ha sido siempre parte de la herencia cristiana. El salterio hace mucho tiempo que es el libro de oración de la Iglesia junto con algunos himnos y cánticos, que provienen de otros libros de la Biblia, tanto del Antiguo como del Nuevo Testamento. Entre las oraciones más hermosas que tenemos se encuentra el *Magnificat* de María, el *Benedictus* de Zacarías y el *Nunc Dimittis* de Simeón, todos en el Evangelio de Lucas (Lucas 1:46–55; 1:68–79; 2:29–32).

Lo más importante es que Jesús oró. Piensa en eso por un momento. Jesús, el Hijo de Dios, la Palabra hecha carne, Hijo único del Padre, oró. Sabemos que se retiró a orar solo. Así lo hizo antes de los momentos más importantes de su ministerio, como cuando fue a escoger a los que estarían más cerca de él. Pero podemos asumir con seguridad que lo hacía como un hábito.

Por eso merece nuestra atención que, cuando uno de los discípulos le pidió que los enseñaran a orar, Jesús respondió con el Padrenuestro. Esta oración revela el corazón de Jesús y nos dice cómo debemos hablar con el Padre. La oración consta de dos partes: la primera bendice al Padre y le pide su presencia en el mundo, la segunda suplica a Dios por nuestras necesidades básicas de alimento, perdón y fidelidad.

Las parábolas que le siguen nos exhortan a perseverar y persistir en nuestra oración, porque Dios es un Padre que nos dará lo más vital, o sea, su Espíritu Santo a todos los que lo pidan. PRAYER AND SERVICE

How do we bring balance and joy to our lives of prayer and service to our loving God?

In the Gospel today, Jesus tells Martha that her concern about doing the right thing as dictated by Jewish tradition might not be the best use of her energies. Her sister, Mary, who sits in rapt attention at Jesus' feet, should not be rebuked. Is Jesus trying to show Martha that she needs to make time for her spiritual nourishment?

Abraham and Sarah in the first reading seem to be just like Martha. And yet Abraham's eager welcome and joyful serving of his "visitors" seems almost spiritual. How like Paul, in the second reading, rejoicing in his service to the gospel!

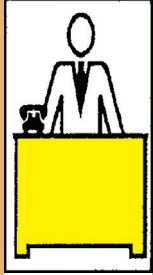
