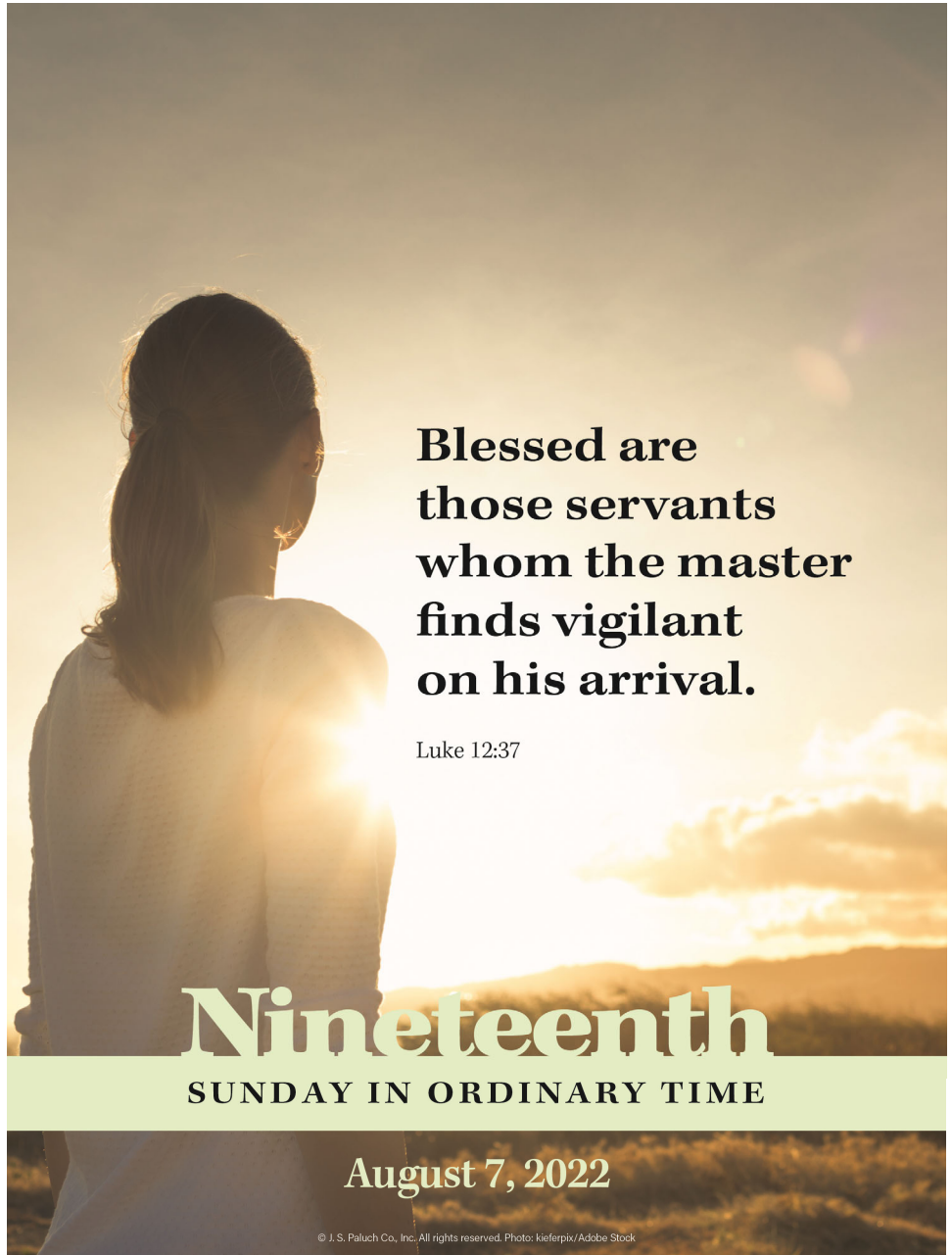

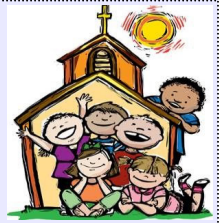

He was ordained in 2013 in the Archdiocese of San Antonio, and is a missionary of the Congregation of the Immaculate Heart of Mary. As a missionary in Africa, he dedicated himself to the service of the sick, elderly, orphans, abandoned children and vulnerable communities.



Father Kumanda has ministered in the San Antonio Archdiocese, Raleigh Diocese & is currently in Arlington. He has served as an Associate Pastor & remains involved in Hospital, Hospice and Social ministry. He is fluent in English, Spanish and French. His passion and love for the abandoned, suffering & vulnerable children of God, led him to join Cross Catholic Outreach where he hopes to inspire others to bring hope and life to the poorest of the poor around.

Reflection on Today's Scripture Readings

It's tempting to wish that our faith in God enabled us to have an unfailing trust that God will take us where we want to be. It would free us from dithering with decisions, vacillating and second-guessing. Only that wouldn't be faith because it would be our own script, we'd have God carrying out.

Faith in God surrenders the script. It also surrenders the outcome, which is why Abraham, when asked by God to pack up kin and belongings and move to another land, did just that without knowing where or how he'd eventually settle in. And much later, like the unpredictable thread of a good novel, Abraham's story finds him and Sarah with child when they are 100 and 90 years old. A decade or so later, Abraham again finds himself without any sensible or sane understanding of the storyline as he leads young Isaac up a sacrificial mountain to what would seem to be a failure of God's promise to Abraham to father countless generations. Once more God rewrites the ending. Throughout Abraham's life it is God's script that Abraham lives out, not his own.

Faith is unpredictable, like good novels that twist and turn and keep us in suspense. If novels are well written, they keep us up long into the night. On the other hand, we like our lives quite the opposite. The appearance of the unpredictable tends to unsettle and undo our living. We presume that good lives, unlike a good novel, are interesting and engaging but always deliberately focused and free of unwarranted surprises. And so, we expect good novels and good lives to be like the tracks of the railroad—parallel, but never touching or crossing lest someone or something be derailed. —Rev. Joseph J. Reflexión de las Escrituras de Hoy

Resultaría tentador desear que con nuestra fe y confianza ciega en Dios conseguiremos que Dios nos lleve a donde nosotros queremos; que no tendremos que lidiar con decisiones, vacilaciones ni tratar de adivinar lo que hacer. Pero esto en realidad no sería fe, porque Dios estaría obrando por nuestra propia decisión.

La fe en Dios renuncia a tener nuestro propio conveniencia. También renuncia a desear los resultados deseados, lo cual fue lo que hizo Abraham cuando Dios le pidió recoger a su familia y sus bienes, y mudarse a otra tierra sin saber ni dónde ni cómo habitarían. Y mucho después, como el desenlace impredecible de una buena novela, Abraham y Sara a la edad de 100 y 90 años respectivamente, esperan un hijo. Más o menos una década después Abraham vuelve a encontrarse frente a una situación en la que no puede entender ni sensible ni sensatamente la trama, pues cuando lleva al joven Isaac hacia la montaña del sacrificio, todo parece contradecir la promesa que le había hecho Dios de ser el padre de innumerables generaciones. Durante toda su vida Abraham sigue el deseo de Dios, no el suyo propio.

La fe es imprevisible como las buenas novelas, cuyas tramas son difíciles de predecir y nos mantienen en suspenso. Las novelas bien desarrolladas mantienen nuestra atención y hasta nos desvelan leyéndolas. Pero a nosotros nos gusta vivir la vida de una manera completamente opuesta. Todo lo imprevisible parece perturbarnos y deshacer nuestra vida. Suponemos que una buena vida tiene que ser interesante y atractiva, como una buena novela, pero siempre y cuando tenga un propósito bien enfocado, y esté desprovista de sorpresas inexcusables. Y por eso esperamos que las buenas novelas así como una vida buena sean como los rieles del tren, paralelos y que nunca se lleguen a tocar ni a cruzarse, pues si no, algo o alguien podría descarrilarse. —Padre Joseph J.
