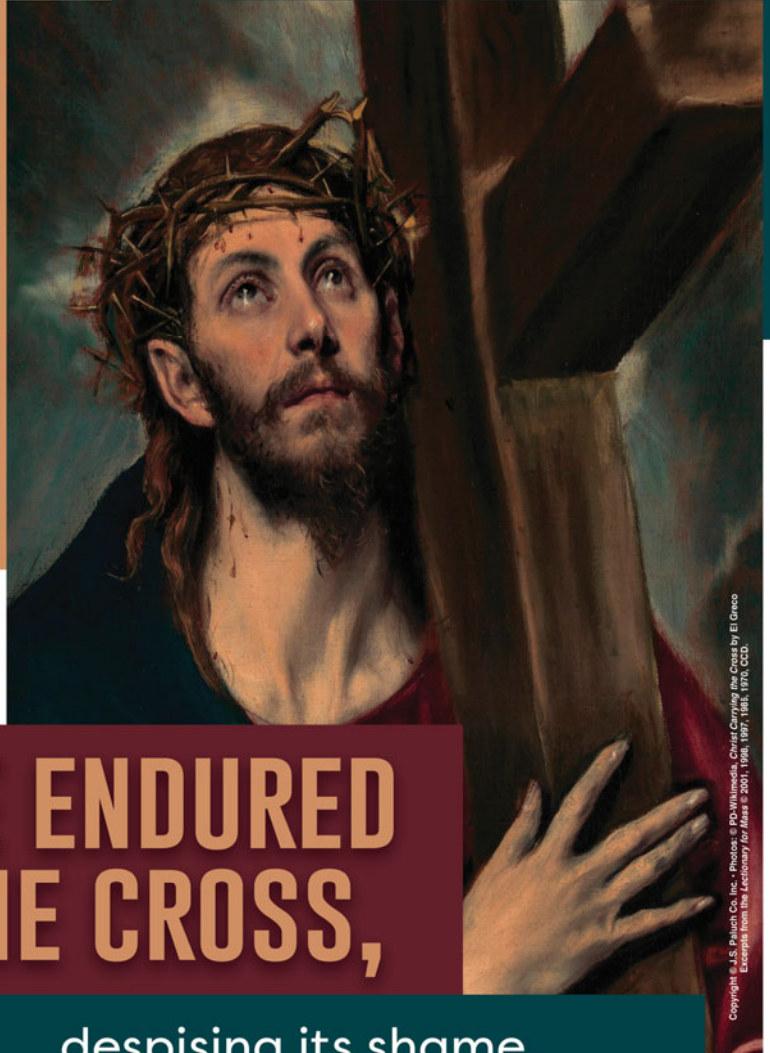

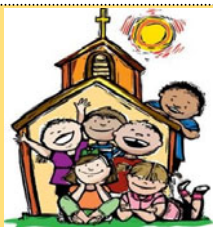

Reflection on Today's Scripture Readings

By now just about all of summer has been unwrapped and spent. As the season drains away and summer's light dims, so too grows the realization that the busy work of life must soon be taken up in earnest once more. Once more the realization returns that life calls us seriously to particular autumn cares. No matter how fearful or challenging, each of us must follow that inner voice or else sense that life will have become less.

Such was the story of Jeremiah, who found himself prophet to the Hebrew people. He sensed an inner call to speak God's word against the nation's political alliances and against the king's penchant to trust in military machines. As a result Jeremiah found himself tossed into a well. Yet he remained committed.

It is also the story of Jesus, who came with truth as a walking stick and the kingdom as seeds of life to be scattered and sown. He also knew full well that few would walk where he would walk or choose to feed on what he would sow. Yet he would not back away from what he was about.

Such a willingness to stretch ourselves into the unknown is part of that mysterious list of things that make us human. At such times we walk in the shadow of Jesus as he leads us into new ways of being human. Seldom, if ever, is it without struggle or even pain, yet it is then that we begin to gain a fuller sense of who we truly are, and it is then that through us God brings the world to something new. —Rev. Reflexión de las Escrituras de Hoy

Para estas alturas casi todo el verano ha pasado. Una vez más la vida vuelve a llamarnos seriamente a las particularidades del otoño con sus propios quehaceres. Así fue la historia de Jeremías, que se vio convertido en profeta entre el pueblo hebreo. Como resultado Jeremías fue echado en un pozo; no obstante, se mantuvo fiel a su compromiso.

También fue así la historia de Jesús, que trajo la verdad como un bastón y el reino como semillas de vida, que se riegan y se siembran. Él también supo muy bien que muy pocos caminarían por donde él caminaba o se alimentarían de lo que él sembraba; no obstante, nunca dejó de ser quien era.

Esa clase de fuerza de voluntad, que nos hace extendernos hacia lo desconocido, es parte de esa lista misteriosa de cosas que nos hace humanos. En esos momentos caminamos a la sombra de Jesús, que nos dirige hacia nuevas maneras de ser humanos. 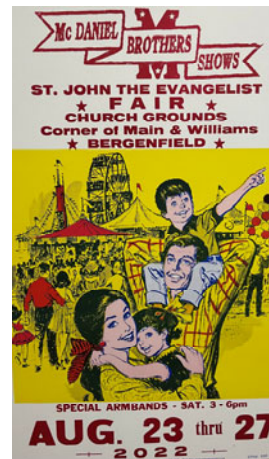
