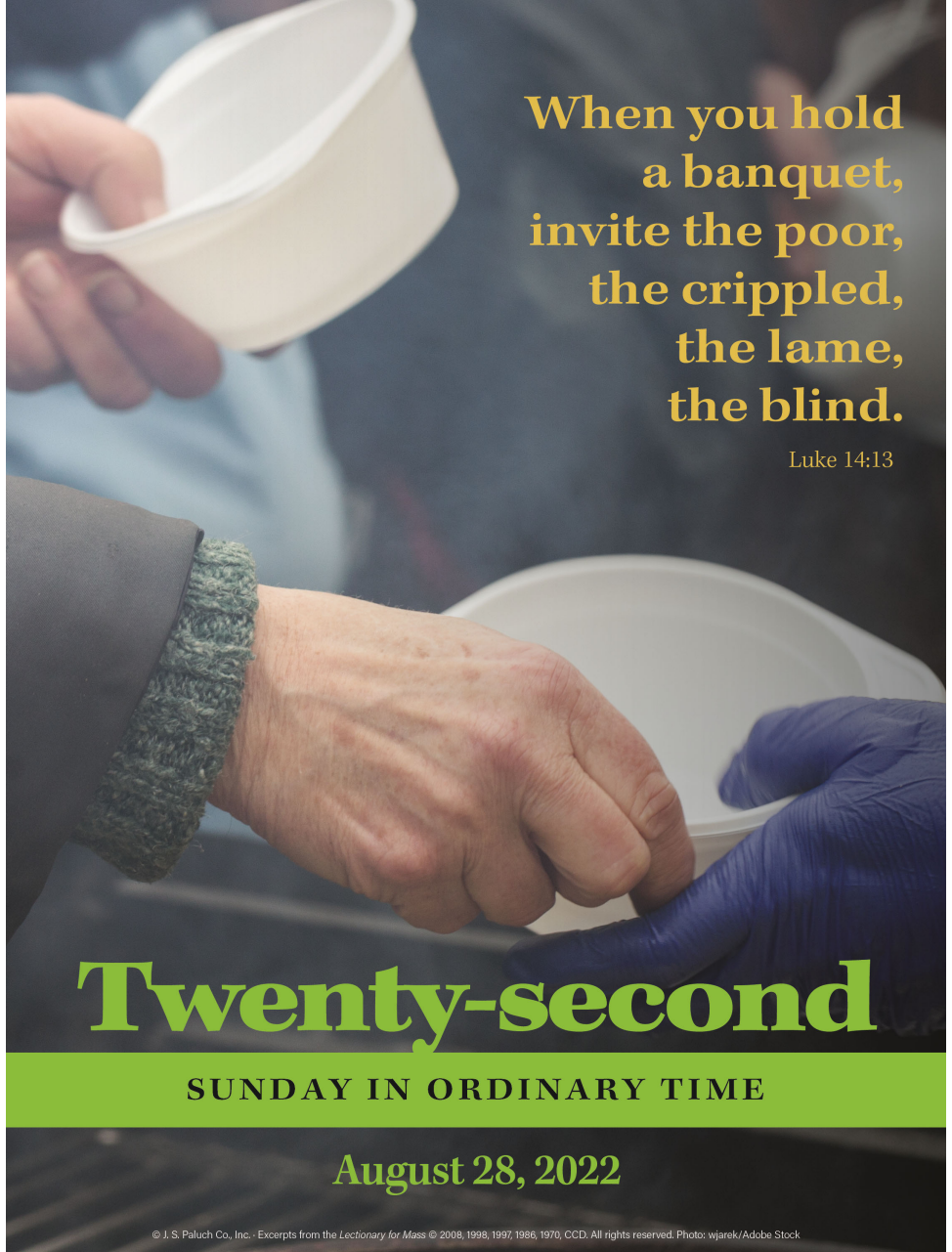

Dear Parishioners,

Thank you to all who helped at, contributed to, or came to our Parish Carnival. Once all the bills get paid and profits determined, I will give you our final report.

I am once again grateful for all those families who made pledges for the 2022 Annual Appeal. Your pledges were 23% over our goal of \$104,591.00, totaling \$128,713.66, and payments made by June 30 were \$117,448.66. If all eligible pledges are paid in full by December 31st, our maximum parish rebate would be \$24,122.66. I encourage those who are still making payments to complete them before the end of the year. Because we did so well, the Archdiocese has decided to give us our first rebate now, based on the amount already paid over our pledge goal, which is \$12,857.66, and the balance based on completed payments in January, which could be as high as \$11,265.00.

As noted in the "pray for" section of today's bulletin, we celebrated the funeral of Joan Sommers this past week. Joan was a devoted parishioner who also served in a variety of positions in our rectory for over 40 years. Surely God will reward her generously for her loving service!

Reflection on Today's Scripture Readings

The story is told of a priest who was a brilliant scholar and an extraordinary lecturer. His one concern in life was the position he would hold at God's eternal banquet. One night, in a dream, an angel revealed that he should expect to be seated next to the butcher from Regenber. The priest was aghast. Surely a mistake, he thought. He decided to set out for Regenber to see the man who would be his companion for eternity. As he traveled, he thought to himself that perhaps this butcher was really a man of great distinction who had fallen on hard times and was temporarily forced to cut meat for a living. With that thought, he tried to console himself.

In Regenber, the priest found the butcher working quietly at his trade. He asked him if he had been a butcher all his life. The butcher replied, "Yes, I have, my good man, but I'm a second-rate butcher. You see, I have not had much time to devote to my trade. I have two elderly parents and they are very helpless in the daily tasks of life. As a result, much of my time is consumed in their care. Every day I must bathe them, clothe them, and feed them. And there's the cleaning and washing of clothes."

Generally speaking, at a parish fundraiser, you pay money and receive something in return, it's just a financial transaction. This is opposed to our parish offertory at Holy Mass, where you unite your sacrifice with Jesus', renewing our covenant relationship with Him.

Una vez más, estoy agradecido por todas las familias que hicieron promesas para la Llamada Anual del 2022. Reflexión de las Escrituras de Hoy

Se cuenta la historia de un sacerdote que era un académico brillante y un extraordinario conferenciante. La mayor preocupación de su vida era la posición que ocuparía en el banquete eterno de Dios. Una noche en sueños un ángel le reveló que él se sentaría junto al carnicero de Regensburg. El sacerdote se horrorizó y pensó que seguramente era un error. Decidió ir a Rogensburg y ver al hombre que lo acompañaría por toda la eternidad. Mientras viajaba pensó que tal vez este carnicero sería un hombre muy distinguido, que había atravesado por momentos difíciles y se vio forzado a cortar carne temporalmente, para ganarse la vida. Así pensando trataba de consolarse.

En Regensburg el sacerdote encontró al carnicero discretamente trabajando en su oficio. Le preguntó si había sido carnicero toda su vida. El carnicero le respondió: "Si, buen hombre, pero soy un carnicero de segunda clase, pues no he tenido mucho tiempo para dedicarme a mi oficio. Mis padres son ancianos y no pueden valerse por sí mismos, así es que la mayor parte de mi tiempo se consume atendiéndolos a ellos. Todos los días debo bañarlos, vestirlos y darles de comer. Además, hay que limpiar y lavar la ropa".
