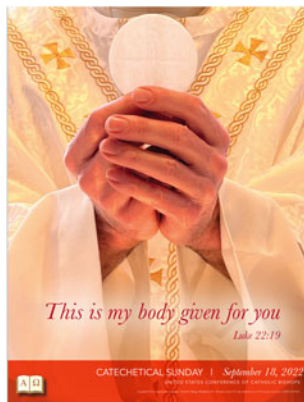

## *Pastor's Desk*

Dear Parishioners,

Today we celebrate Catechetical Sunday. This year's theme, "This is My Body, given for you!" is most appropriate, not only because our Religious Education program prepares children and adults for the sacraments, but also because those catechists who assist us in this mission give themselves for others, in union with Christ Who has given Himself to us and for us all. At the same time, we are reminded how precious the gift of Jesus really present in the Eucharist is for all of us Catholic people. There is no substitute for receiving Jesus in Holy Communion. See more about today's observance on page 2 in today's bulletin.

Last month I mentioned the substantial rebate our parish has received and will continue to receive on completed pledges to the Annual Appeal. Another benefit of your overwhelming support of this Appeal is that we will also qualify for a 2% reduction in the assessments we (and every other parish) have to pay for the ongoing support of the Archdiocese. This amounts to a saving of \$18,158.00. In total, then, if all those who have pledged complete their payments before December 31, 2022, our parish will have received \$24,122.66 in rebates and \$18,158.00 in reduced assessments, totaling **\$42,280.66**. Once again, **thank you to everyone who participated in this year's appeal!**

Parishioners from the Neocatechumenal Way will be inviting you this weekend to consider attending a 15 session catechesis series Tuesday and Friday evenings in the school library. It is a great way to deepen your understanding of our Catholic faith. It is also a wonderful opportunity to invite someone you know who may have been away from church practice for awhile.

Next weekend, representatives of Bethlehem Handicrafts will be with us once again selling their beautiful hand-carved olive wood articles, which helps Christian families in the Holy Land to sustain themselves among a population which ironically is not always welcoming to them and during a period of more limited tourism. Please consider purchasing something for yourself or as a gift for someone else!

### *Reflection on Today's Scripture Readings*

When Jacob Marley appears to Ebenezer Scrooge at the beginning of *A Christmas Carol*, he wears a long chain, clasped around his middle, "made of cash-boxes, keys, padlocks, ledgers, deeds, and heavy purses wrought in steel." He tells Scrooge that he wears the chain he forged in life, and now he wanders the earth because in life his spirit never went beyond "the narrow limits of our money-changing hole." Old Marley's life had been about money until it ended; now he pays the price.

Luke calls on his community to consider its use of money. In today's parable a steward has been caught squandering his master's property. Seeing that his days are numbered, the steward acts quickly to ensure that he will have friends at the end. Surprisingly, the master commends him for "acting prudently." Jesus then comments that the children of this world have more gumption than the children of light, using their money to make friends.

Three other comments follow: Use money to make friends for eternity; trustworthiness in small matters and earthly wealth will lead to being trusted with true wealth, i.e. God's kingdom; and you have to choose between God and "mammon" (whatever holds your deepest trust other than God). In a nutshell, use your money to serve; allow God to save.

Jesus is in line with the prophet Amos, who castigates the businessmen of his day for cheating the poor and needy. God is on the side of these little ones. They are the ones we are to befriend by using our money for their good. Jesus, who came as a "ransom for all" (1 Timothy 2:4), is our true wealth. —James A. Wallace, C.S.S.R. Estimados Feligreses,

Hoy celebramos el Domingo de Catequesis. Entonces, en total, si todos los que se han comprometido completan sus pagos antes del 31 de diciembre de 2022, nuestra parroquia habrá recibido \$24,122.66 en reembolsos y \$18,158.00 en contribuciones reducidas, totalizando \$42,280.66. Una vez más, ¡gracias a todos los que participaron en el llamado de este año!

### *Reflexión de las Escrituras de Hoy*

Cuando Jacob Marley se le apareció a Ebenezer Scrooge al comienzo de la película estadounidense *A Christmas Carol* (“Los Fantasmas de Navidad” en Latinoamérica y en España “Cuento de Navidad”) se le ve con una larga cadena ceñida a su cuerpo y “hecha de arcas de seguridad, llaves, candados, registros de contabilidad, escrituras y bolsas pesadas de acero”. Él le dice a Scrooge que lleva la cadena que él mismo se forjó en vida y ahora vaga por la tierra, “porque en mi vida terrenal nunca mi espíritu vagó más allá de los estrechos límites de nuestra ventanilla para el cambio”. La vida del viejo Marley había sido avariciosa hasta el final; ahora pagaba el precio.

El evangelista Lucas exhorta a su comunidad a considerar el uso de su dinero. En la parábola de hoy un administrador ha sido sorprendido despilfarrando los bienes de su amo. Viendo que sus días como empleado estaban contados el administrador actuó prontamente asegurándose de poder contar con amigos al final. Sorprendentemente el amo lo elogia porque “había obrado sagazmente”. Jesús dice entonces que los que pertenecen a este mundo, usando su dinero para hacer amistades, son más hábiles que los que pertenecen a la luz.

Otros comentarios siguen: Gánense amigos que, cuando ustedes mueran, los reciban en el cielo; el que es fiel en las cosas pequeñas, también es fiel en las grandes, por ejemplo, fiel al reino de Dios; y no hay criado que pueda servir a dos amos, o sea, no se puede servir a Dios y al dinero. En pocas palabras, usa tu dinero para servir a Dios.

Jesús está de acuerdo con el profeta Amós, que castiga a los empresarios de su época por engañar a los pobres y necesitados. Dios está al lado de estos pequeños y son con los que debemos hacer amistad y usar nuestro dinero para beneficio de ellos. Jesús, “que se entregó como rescate por todos” (1 Timoteo 2:6), es nuestra verdadera riqueza. —James A. Wallace, C.S.S.R. *Derechos de autor* © 2012, *World Library Publications. 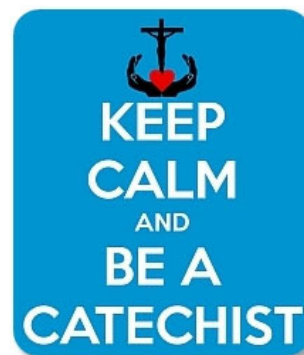

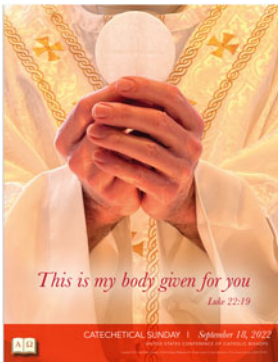

“Este es mi cuerpo entregado por ustedes”

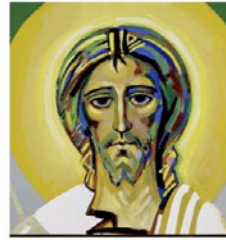

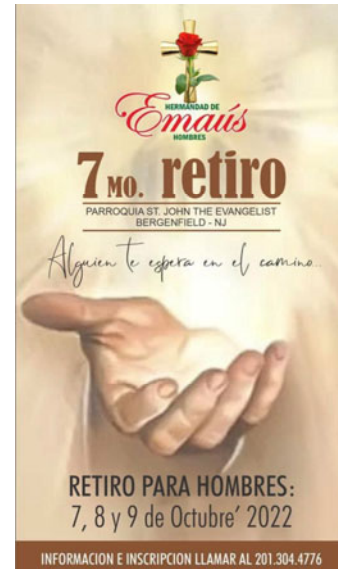
