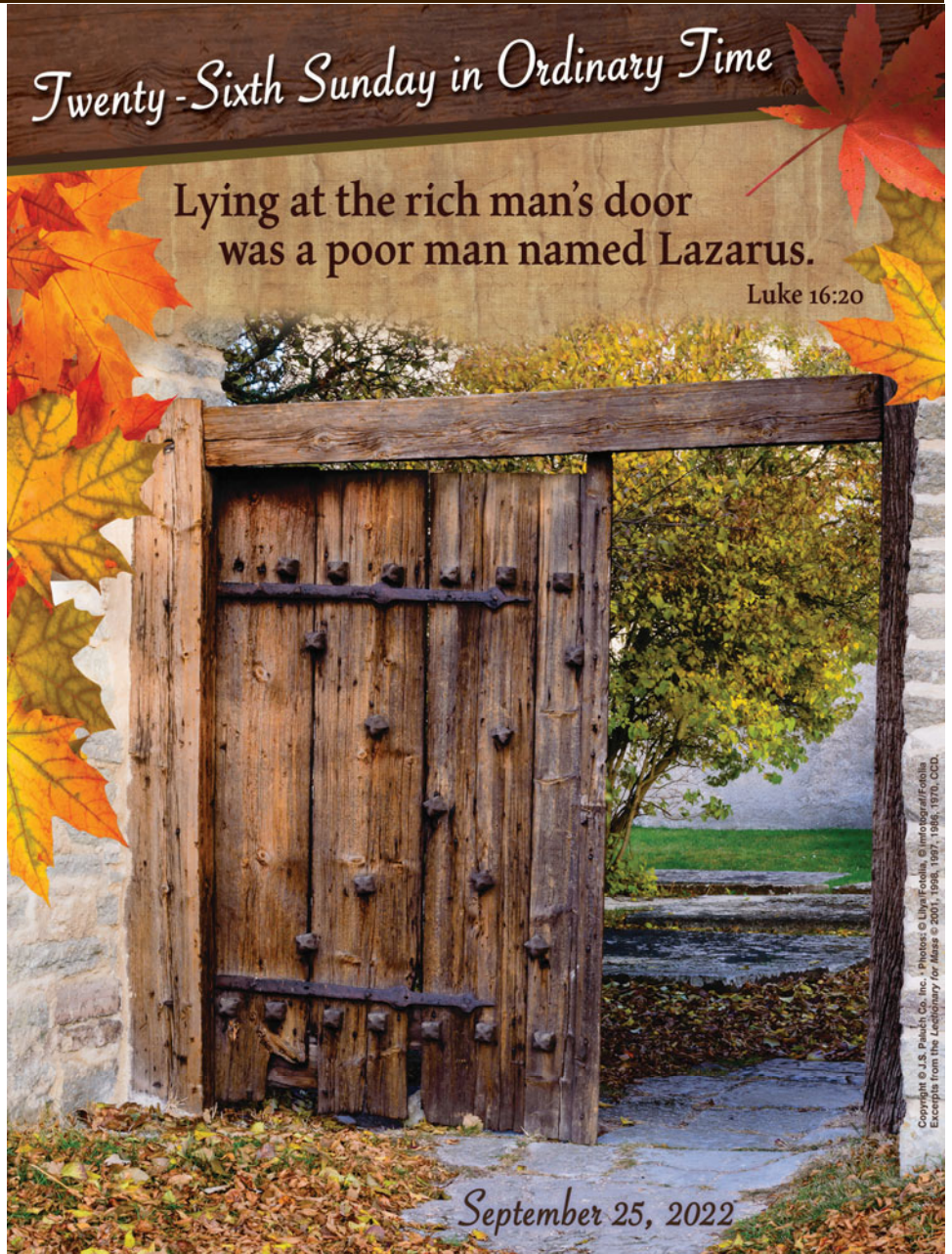

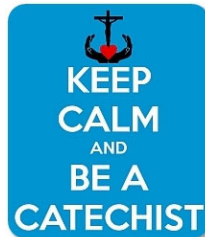

Reflection on Today's Scripture Readings

If anyone is the prophet of the punch line, it is Amos. He travels up from the south to preach to the people of the northern kingdom of Israel and he pulls no punches. “Woe to the complacent,” he begins, and then in a quick series of brush strokes lets them know how God sees them: lying upon their beds, stretched out on their couches, eating their tender lamb and calves, drinking fine wine while the music plays and they anoint themselves with the best oils. Then the punch line—they shall be the first to go into exile. The party is over!

In a similar vein Jesus paints a portrait of “Richman”—tradition has named him *Dives* (Latin for “rich man”)—dressed in the best, eating the best, insulated in his own little world, while at his door Lazarus lies starving, with only dogs coming to lick his sores. It is a scene of total indifference to the plight of the poor. God’s response is clear. The wheel will turn. And when it does, so shall Lazarus and Richman. What was a gap between them becomes a chasm.

The Letter to Timothy today contains advice from a mentor to his beloved child in the faith. It offers of profile of how the baptized person is to live. It’s a shame that the reading does not begin earlier (1 Timothy 6:9–10) and end later (6:17–19), because these verses directly warn about the dangers of money, offering advice for the wealthy so that they may “lay hold of eternal life” (6:12).

Reflexión de las Escrituras de Hoy

Si hay algún profeta de quien se pueda decir que llega al punto clave, ése es Amós. Viaja desde el sur para predicar en el norte al pueblo del reino de Israel y lo hace de manera clara y directa. Empieza diciendo, “¡Ay de los que se sienten seguros!” y entonces hace una serie de descripciones rápidas de cómo Dios los ve a ellos: duermen en camas de marfil, se sientan a sus anchas en sus sillones, comen los corderos del rebaño y los terneros del establo, canturrean al son del arpa mientras beben el vino en elegantes copas y se ungen con delicados perfumes. Y entonces llega al punto clave: Irán al desierto a la cabeza de los deportados. ¡Se acabó la fiesta!

De una manera similar Jesús nos pinta al “hombre rico” (a quien la tradición a llamado *Epulón*, que viene de “épulos” y que el Diccionario de la Real Academia española define como “hombre que come y se regala mucho”) vestido con lo mejor y comiendo lo más exquisito, aislado en su propio mundo mientras Lázaro pasa hambre y hasta los perros venían a lamer sus llagas. Es una escena que demuestra una indiferencia total hacia la condición del pobre. La respuesta de Dios es clara. El panorama va a cambiar. Y así también cambiarán Lázaro y el rico Epulón. La distancia entre ellos se convertirá en un abismo.

El pasaje de hoy de la carta a Timoteo contiene los consejos de un mentor a su amado hijo en la fe y ofrece un cuadro de cómo debe vivir una persona bautizada. Es una pena que esta lectura de hoy no comience unos versículos antes (1 Timoteo 6:9–10) y termine unos versículos después (6:17–19), porque esos versículos advierten directamente acerca de los peligros del dinero y entre los consejos que ofrecen a los ricos les dice: “conquista la vida eterna” (6:12). —James A. 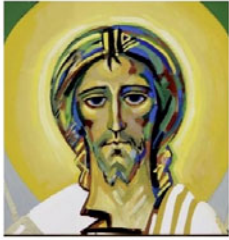
