Blessing the Infant Jesus at Home

Readers and one person are chosen to hold the Infant Jesus.

Soft Christmas hymn playing as family and friends gather around the Christmas tree and the Nativity stable.

Reader 1 begins: In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

Reader 2: As we prepare to celebrate the birth of Christ we pause to bless the infant Jesus that we will place in our manger. The practice of erecting such mangers was begun by St. Francis as a means to send forth the message of Christmas. When we look upon the figure of the Infant Jesus, the Christmas Gospel comes alive and we are moved to rejoice in the mystery of the Incarnation of the Son of God.

The Infant Jesus will now be held up as **Reader 3** reads the Blessing.

God of every nation and people, From the very beginning of creation You have made manifest your love; When our need for a Savior was great you sent your Son to be born of the Virgin Mary. To our lives He brings joy and peace, justice, mercy, and love. Lord, bless all who look upon this infant; May it remind us of the humble birth of Jesus, and raise up our thoughts to Him, who is God-with-us and Savior of all, and who lives and reigns forever and ever. Amen.

The Infant Jesus is now placed in the manger.

Reader 1: Let us pray the Hail Mary together.

Reader 2: Let us now exchange a Sign of Peace.

You may now choose to sing a Christmas Carol as the Blessing of the Infant Jesus is concluded.
