



From the Pastor

Dear Brothers and Sisters



'If you pull up the weeds, you might uproot the wheat.' (Mt. 13:29)

A Church that had room only for saints and those leading impeccable moral lives would make about as much sense as a hospital that had room only for the healthy!

We are very complex people. All of us. There is, in all of us, a great mixture of good and bad, of love and hate, of gentleness and violence, wheat and weeds.

Oskar Schindler, the German industrialist, saved over a thousand Polish Jews from the Nazi concentration camps in the Second World War. One of these Polish Jews said of him: 'He was our father, he was our mother, he was our only hope, and he never let us down'.

But Oskar Schindler was no saint. He was riddled with contradictions. He was unfaithful to his wife. He womanized. He drank. He was a liar. He was a Catholic, but only in name. Once a paid up member of the Nazi Party, he was determined to end the war with 'two trunks full of money'. But there was another and better side to him. The side that protected his workers from the death camps at considerable risk.

Human nature is fallen. Within each one of us there is a battle between good and bad, light and darkness, strength and weakness, loyalty and betrayal, wheat and darnel.

We must acknowledge the dark side of ourselves, without conceding victory to it. Acknowledge that we are flawed, some of us badly.

We need to be hospitable to ourselves, showing ourselves the right kind of compassion and mercy.

And we need to show the same hospitality, the same leniency to others – especially to the people we share our lives with, at home and at work.

To concentrate on other people's failings and sins can blind us to their virtues.

It is easy to voice criticisms and gripes, while omitting to offer a word of encouragement and appreciation.


We can all make mistakes, sometimes disastrous ones. We can all sin, sometimes seriously, but we can all be redeemed.

We will not be judged by a single act or by one stage in life. We will be judged by our whole life.

That is why judgment cannot come until the end, as the Gospel tells us. Some people, as soon as they discover your weakness, write you off.

But God, thankfully, is not some people.

iUna Iglesia que tuviera espacio solo para los santos y aquellos que llevan vidas morales impecables tendría tanto sentido como un hospital que tuviera espacio solo para los sanos!

Somos personas muy complejas. Todos nosotros. Hay, en todos nosotros, una gran mezcla de bien y de mal, de amor y de odio, de dulzura y de violencia, de trigo y de cizaña.

Oskar Schindler, el industrial alemán, salvó a más de mil judíos polacos de los campos de concentración nazis en la Segunda Guerra Mundial. Uno de estos judíos polacos dijo de él: 'Era nuestro padre, era nuestra madre, era nuestra única esperanza, y nunca nos defraudó'.

Pero Oskar Schindler no era un santo. Estaba lleno de contradicciones. Era infiel a su esposa. Era mujeriego. Bebía. Era un mentiroso. Era católico, pero solo de nombre. El fue un miembro pagado del Partido Nazi una vez y estaba decidido a poner fin a la guerra con 'dos baúles llenos de dinero'. Pero había otra parte buena de él. El lado que protegía a sus trabajadores de los campos de la muerte corría un riesgo considerable.

La naturaleza humana ha caído. Dentro de cada uno de nosotros hay una batalla entre el bien y el mal, la luz y la oscuridad, la fuerza y la debilidad, la lealtad y la traición, el trigo y zurullo.

Debemos reconocer el lado oscuro de nosotros mismos, sin concederle la victoria. Reconocer que somos defectuosos, algunos de nosotros mal.

Necesitamos ser hospitalarios con nosotros mismos, mostrándonos el tipo correcto de compasión y misericordia.

Y tenemos que mostrar la misma hospitalidad, la misma indulgencia a los demás - especialmente a las personas con las que compartimos nuestras vidas, en casa y en el trabajo.


Concentrarnos en los errores y pecados de otras personas puede cegarnos a sus virtudes.






RIFA 50-50
