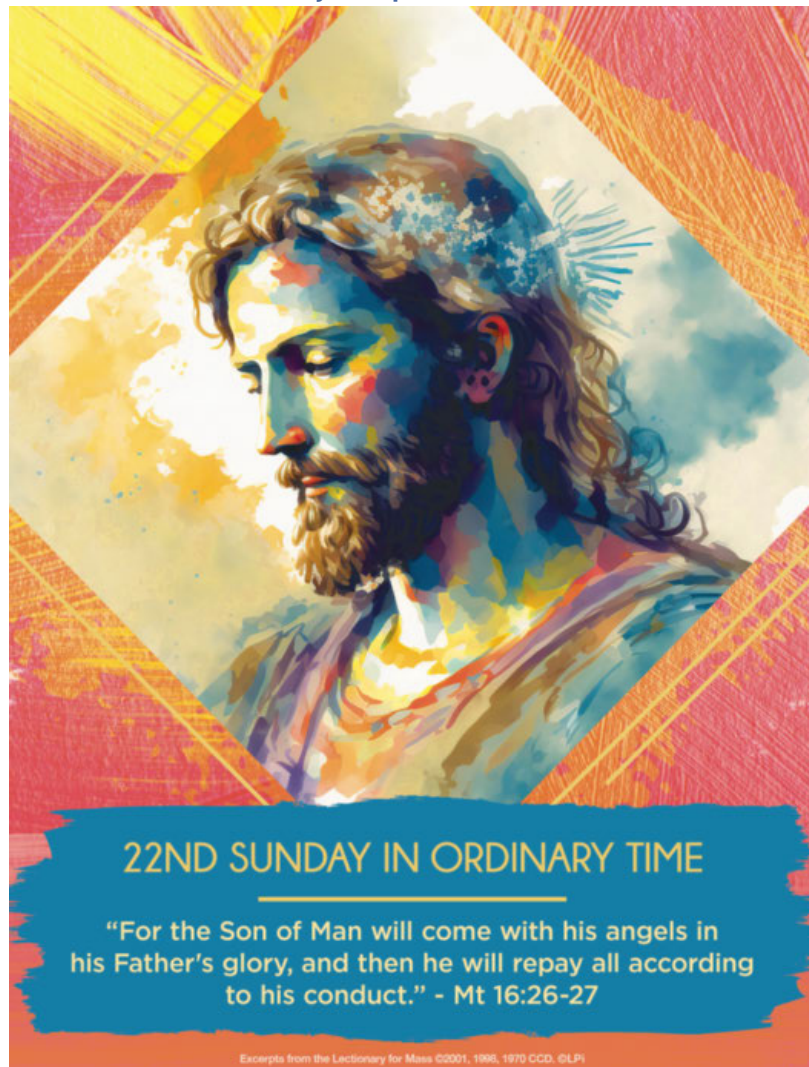

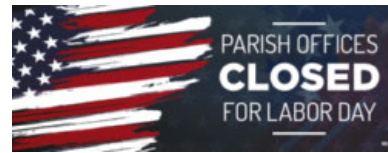

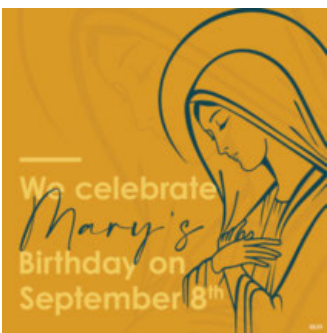

## From the Pastor

Dear Brothers and Sisters



"Jesus began to show his disciples that he must go to Jerusalem and suffer greatly."

Soon we will feel the first cool freshness that announces the end of summer and the beginning of Fall and the colder days ahead. This, in tandem with the Gospel today in which Jesus prophesied his suffering, brings to mind an event in the life of St. Francis of Assisi.

Francis was once traveling to one of the Franciscan houses - St. Mary of the Angels- with Brother Leo. It was a bitterly cold day, and they were freezing. St. Francis called to Brother Leo, who was walking ahead of him: "Brother Leo, even if the Friars Minor in every country give a great example of holiness and integrity and good edification, nevertheless write down and note carefully that perfect joy is not in that."

And when he had walked a little farther, St. Francis called again, saying: "Brother Leo, even if a Friar Minor gives sight to the blind, heals the paralyzed, drives out devils, gives hearing back to the deaf, makes the lame walk, and restores speech to the dumb, and what is still more, brings back to life a man who has been dead four days, write that perfect joy is not in that."

And little while later, St. Francis cried out again in a strong voice: "Brother Leo, if a Friar Minor knew all languages and all sciences and Scripture, if he also knew how to prophesy and to reveal not only the future but also the secrets of the consciences and minds of others, write down and note carefully that perfect joy is not in that."

They continued walking in the bitter cold when St. Francis called again strongly: "Brother Leo, even if a Friar Minor could preach so well that he should convert all infidels to the faith of Christ, write that perfect joy is not there."

After this had gone on for a distance of two miles, Brother Leo in great amazement asked him: "Father, I beg you in God's name to tell me where perfect joy is."

And St. Francis replied; "When we come to St. Mary of the Angels, soaked by the rain and frozen by the cold, all soiled with mud and suffering from hunger, and we ring at the gate of the Place and the brother porter comes and says angrily: 'Who are you?' And we say: 'We are two of your brothers.' And he contradicts us, saying: 'You are not telling the truth. Rather you are two rascals who go around deceiving people and stealing what they give to the poor. Go away' And he does not open for us, but makes us stand outside in the snow and rain, cold and hungry, until night falls-then if we endure all those insults and cruel rebuffs patiently, without being troubled and without complaining, and if we reflect humbly and charitably that that porter really knows us and that God makes him speak against us, oh, Brother Leo, write that perfect joy is there!

'And if we continue to knock, and the porter comes out in anger, and drives us away with curses and hard blows like bothersome scoundrels, saying; 'Get away from here, you dirty thieves-go to the hospital! Who do you think you are? You certainly won't eat or sleep here;' and if we bear it patiently and take the insults with joy and love in our hearts, Oh, Brother Leo, write that that is perfect joy!

And if later, suffering intensely from hunger and the painful cold, with night falling, we still knock and call, and crying loudly begging them to open for us for the love of God, and he grows still more angry and says: 'Those fellows are bold and shameless ruffians. I'll give them what they deserve.' And he comes out with a knotty club, and grasping us by the cowl throws us onto the ground, rolling us in the mud and snow, and beats us with that club so much that he covers our bodies with wounds - if we endure all those evils and insults and blows with joy and patience, reflecting that we must accept and bear the sufferings of the Blessed Christ patiently for love of Him, oh, Brother Leo, write: that is perfect joy!

'And now hear the conclusion, Brother Leo. Above all the graces and gifts of the Holy Spirit which Christ gives to His friends is that of conquering oneself and willingly enduring sufferings, insults, humiliations, and hardships for the love of Christ. For we cannot glory in all those other marvelous gifts of God, as they are not ours but God's, as the Apostle says: 'What have you that you have not received?' But we can glory in the cross of tribulations and afflictions, because that is ours, and so the Apostle says: 'I will not glory save in the Cross of Our Lord Jesus Christ.'"

To whom be honor and glory forever and ever. Amen.

## Del Pastor

*Queridos hermanos y hermanas*



"Jesús comenzó a mostrar a sus discípulos que debía ir a Jerusalén y sufrir mucho."

Pronto sentiremos la primera fresca fresca que anuncia el final del verano y el comienzo del otoño y los días más fríos por venir. Esto, junto con el Evangelio de hoy en el que Jesús profetizó su sufrimiento, nos recuerda un acontecimiento en la vida de San Francisco de Asís.

Francisco viajaba una vez a una de las casas franciscanas - Santa María de los Ángeles- con el hermano León. Era un día muy frío, y estaban helados. San Francisco llamó al hermano León, que caminaba delante de él: "Hermano León, aunque los Frailes Menores de todos los países dan un gran ejemplo de santidad e integridad y de buena edificación, sin embargo escriben y notan cuidadosamente que la alegría perfecta no está en eso."

Y cuando él había caminado un poco más lejos, San Francisco llamó otra vez, decir: "Hermano Leo, incluso si un Fraile Menor da vista a los ciegos, cura a los paralíticos, expulsa a los demonios, devuelve la audición a los sordos, hace que los cojos caminen, y restaura el habla a los mudos, y lo que es más, devuelve a la vida a un hombre que ha estado muerto cuatro días, escribir que la alegría perfecta no está en eso."

Y poco después, San Francisco gritó de nuevo con una voz fuerte: "Hermano Leo, si un Fraile Menor conociera todos los idiomas y todas las ciencias y Escrituras, si también supiera profetizar y revelar no solo el futuro sino también los secretos de las conciencias y las mentes de los demás, anote y note cuidadosamente que la alegría perfecta no está en eso."

Siguieron caminando en el frío amargo cuando San Francisco llamó otra vez fuertemente: "Hermano Leo, incluso si un Friar Minor podría predicar tan bien que él debe convertir todos los infieles a la fe de Cristo, escribir que la alegría perfecta no está allí."

Después de que esto había pasado por una distancia de dos millas, el hermano Leo le preguntó con gran asombro: "Padre, te ruego en nombre de Dios que me digas dónde está la alegría perfecta."

Y San Francisco respondió: "Cuando llegamos a Santa María de los Ángeles, empapada por la lluvia y congelada por el frío, toda manchada de barro y hambrienta, llamamos a la puerta del Lugar y el hermano portero viene y dice airadamente: '¿Quién eres? 'Somos dos de tus hermanos.' Y él nos contradice, diciendo: 'No estás diciendo la verdad. Más bien eres dos sinvergüenzas que van por ahí engañando a la gente y robando lo que dan a los pobres. Vete' Y él no nos abre, pero nos hace estar fuera en la nieve y la lluvia, frío y hambriento, hasta que cae la noche-entonces si soportamos todos esos insultos y crueles rechazos pacientemente, sin ser molestados y sin quejarnos, y si reflexionamos humildemente y caritativamente que ese portero realmente nos conoce y que Dios lo hace hablar contra nosotros, oh, Hermano Leo, ¡Escribe que la alegría perfecta está ahí!

'Y si seguimos golpeando, y el portero sale enojado, y nos aleja con maldiciones y golpes duros como sinvergüenzas molestos, diciendo: '¡Aléjense de aquí, sucios ladrones, vayan al hospital! ¿Quién te crees que eres? Ciertamente no comerás ni dormirás aquí;' y si lo soportamos pacientemente y tomamos los insultos con alegría y amor en nuestros corazones, ¡Oh, Hermano Leo, escribe que eso es alegría perfecta!

Y si más tarde, sufriendo intensamente del hambre y del frío doloroso, con la caída de la noche, todavía llamamos y llamamos, y llorando en voz alta rogándoles que nos abran por el amor de Dios, y él se enoja aún más y dice: 'Esos tipos son rufianes audaces y descarados. Les daré lo que se merecen.' Y él sale con un club nudoso, y agarrándonos de la chimenea nos arroja al suelo, revolcándonos en el barro y la nieve, y nos golpea con ese club tanto que cubre nuestros cuerpos con heridas - si soportamos todos esos males e insultos y golpes con alegría y paciencia, reflejando que debemos aceptar y soportar los sufrimientos del Santísimo Cristo pacientemente por amor a Él, oh, Hermano Leo, escribe: ¡eso es gozo perfecto!

Y ahora escuche la conclusión, Hermano Leo. Sobre todo las gracias y dones del Espíritu Santo que Cristo da a sus amigos es la de conquistarse a sí mismo y soportar voluntariamente sufrimientos, insultos y humillaciones, por amor a Cristo. Porque no podemos gloriarnos en todos esos otros dones maravillosos de Dios, ya que no son nuestros sino de Dios, como dice el Apóstol: '¿Qué tienes que no has recibido? Pero podemos gloriarnos en la cruz de tribulaciones y aflicciones, porque eso es nuestro, y así dice el Apóstol: 'No me gloriaré salvo en la Cruz de Nuestro Señor Jesucristo.'"

A quien sea honor y gloria por los siglos de los siglos. Amén.
