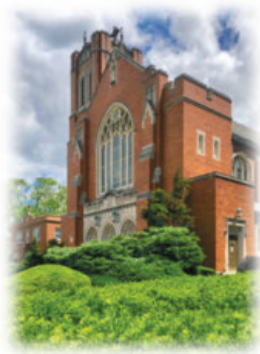

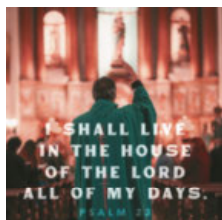

As always, your generosity is greatly appreciated.

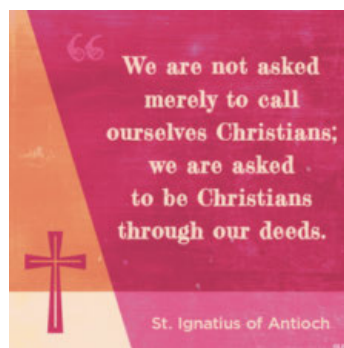
Anointing Mass

A Reflection From Our Pastor

Dear Brothers and Sisters



'The king came into the wedding feast but saw a man not dressed in a wedding garment.....Bind his hands and his feet, and cast him out into the darkness outside, where there will be wailing and grinding of teeth.'

My sister told me something that happened a few years ago. One of my nephews, Tom, her middle child, got mixed up with the wrong crowd when he was 17 and began to go off the deep end. For a year or more his behavior was out of control; he had no respect for the house or his parents, he became an unruly lout. My sister was at wits end, many days reduced to tears, until one day she realized what she had to do.

She bought him clean clothes and toiletries, and took him to the homeless shelter. When Tom asked why they were there, my sister replied 'This is your new home.' He thought she was joking, but the penny dropped and he saw that she meant it. He got mad, 'What? So you're kicking me out of the house?' he screamed. 'No' my sister replied, 'I'm respecting your decision, you yourself have chosen not to be part of our family, you have removed yourself! I respect your freedom.' And she left him there.

It was the hardest thing she ever had to do. She cried all the way home, but she knew it had to be done, because this kid was heading for a train wreck if he didn't wake up.

Tom soon discovered that he didn't like the homeless shelter. He quickly found a job, and a place to live. He is now back home with the family, a different person. 'The kingdom of heaven may be likened to...a wedding feast.' We have been invited to this feast, but we can be cast out if we do not have a wedding garment. The Book of Revelation tells us: 'Alleluia, the wedding feast of the Lamb has begun. His bride is ready, and has clothed herself in dazzling white, because her linen is made of the good deeds of the saints.' (Rev. 19; 9)

And: 'I warn you to buy from me...the white robe to clothe you and hide your shameful nakedness.' (Rev. 3; 20-21)

The man in the Gospel was thrown out because he did not have a wedding garment, which means he was naked, which means he was in sin. Perhaps he had a double life, or there was something that he did not want to turn away from. Perhaps he never wanted to open himself to God. Perhaps he had turned his back on God completely. This man goes through the motions of religion, he may even go to church on Sunday, but he certainly does not have a wedding garment. He thinks he is right to get angry, he is justified to judge others, he does not think of himself as proud or arrogant, but blames others for his problems. He is not clothed with the good deeds of the saints. He has no gratitude.

When Adam sinned he discovered that he was naked, and afraid, and he hid from God. 'Who told you that you were naked?' God asks him, 'Have you done what I told you not to do?'

When Jesus Christ was crucified they stripped him of his garments. He was crucified for our sins, and he was crucified naked – an image of what sin does to us.

My nephew Tom was thrown out because he didn't have a wedding garment, he was naked. God does not cast us out, God loves the sinner, but he respects our freedom, and we can exclude ourselves from the wedding feast.

But there is a great good news. No matter how naked we are, there is still an opportunity to clothe our nakedness with the wedding garment. This garment is repentance of heart, an experience of the forgiveness of our sin, and a consequent gratitude to God and to others. This garment is offered to each of us as we celebrate the wedding banquet of the liturgy.

Una Reflexión de Nuestro Pastor

Queridos hermanos y hermanas



'Un rey llegó a una fiesta de una boda, vio a un hombre que no estaba vestido para estar en la boda, ató sus manos y pies, y lo tiro afuera a la oscuridad donde había lamentos y gruñir de dientes.'

Mi hermana me conto algo que había pasado unos años atrás con uno de mis sobrinos llamado Tom, su hijo del medio. Él se había juntado con unas personas que andaban en malos pasos cuando él tenía 17 años, desde entonces comenzó a caer en lo más bajo y profundo del lodo. Durante un año o más su conducta estaba fuera de control; no respetaba su casa y a sus padres. Él se volvió insoportable y no respetaba a nadie. Mi hermana ya no podía más tener mal genio y lloraba sin cesar, hasta que un día se le ocurrió algo.

Le compró ropas nuevas, artículos de cuidado personal y lo llevó al refugio de desamparados. Cuando Tom le preguntó por qué estaban allí, mi hermana le respondió: 'Esta es tu nueva casa.' Él pensó que ella estaba bromeando, pero se dio cuenta que era en serio. ¿Se enojó, le grito y le dijo 'me estás botando de la casa?' gritó. Mi hermana le contestó, 'No', '¡Respeto tu decisión que tú mismo has escogido al no querer ser parte de la familia, tú te has separado y respeto tu libertad.' Y lo dejó allí.

Fue lo más difícil que tuvo que hacer. Lloró todo el camino, pero sabía que, si no lo hubiese hecho, su hijo dirigía a su perdición. Ella trato que su hijo no se tropezará y evitarle mayores problemas.

Tom pronto descubrió que no le gustaba el refugio de desamparados. Rápidamente encontró un trabajo y un lugar donde vivir. Ahora está de vuelta en casa con la familia, una persona diferente. 'El reino de los cielos puede ser comparado con...una fiesta de bodas.' Hemos sido invitados a esta fiesta, pero podemos ser expulsados si no tenemos un vestido de boda. El libro del Apocalipsis nos dice: Aleluya, la fiesta de bodas del Cordero ha comenzado. Su novia está lista, y se ha vestido de blanco deslumbrante, porque su lino está hecho de las buenas obras de los santos.' (Apoc. 19; 9)

Y: 'Te advierto que me compres...la túnica blanca para vestirte y ocultar tu desnudez vergonzosa.' (Apoc. 3; 20-21)

El hombre en el Evangelio fue expulsado porque no tenía un vestido de boda, lo que significa que estaba desnudo, lo que significa que estaba en pecado. Quizás tenía una doble vida, o había algo de lo que no quería apartarse. Quizás nunca quiso abrirse a Dios. Quizás le había dado la espalda a Dios completamente. Este hombre pasa por las emociones de la religión, incluso puede ir a la iglesia el domingo, pero ciertamente no tiene un traje de boda. Él piensa que tiene razón en enojarse, que está justificado para juzgar a los demás, que no piensa de sí mismo como orgulloso o arrogante, pero culpa a los demás por sus problemas. No está vestido con las buenas obras de los santos. No tiene gratitud.

Cuando Adán pecó descubrió que estaba desnudo y asustado, y se escondió de Dios. '¿Quién te dijo que estabas desnudo?' Dios le pregunta, '¿Has hecho lo que te dije que no hicieras?'

Cuando Jesucristo fue crucificado lo despojaron de sus vestiduras. Fue crucificado por nuestros pecados, y fue crucificado desnudo - una imagen de lo que el pecado nos hace.

Mi sobrino Tom fue expulsado porque no tenía ropa de boda, estaba desnudo. Dios no nos echa fuera, Dios ama al pecador, pero respeta nuestra libertad, y podemos excluirnos de la fiesta de bodas.

Pero hay una gran buena noticia. No importa cuán desnudos estemos, todavía hay una oportunidad de vestir nuestra desnudez con la ropa de la boda. Esta prenda es el arrepentimiento del corazón, una experiencia del perdón de nuestro pecado, y una consiguiente gratitud a Dios y a los demás. Esta prenda se nos ofrece a cada uno de nosotros mientras celebramos el banquete de bodas de la liturgia.
