

What happened to the pews?

You may have noticed that some pews have been
moved from the nave of the church.

This will allow us to move the Baptismal Font to
the center of the church, affording a more dignified
celebration of the Sacrament of Baptism, with
more space and easier participation for families.

Secondly, the new location of the Font will
enhance the way we celebrate Funeral Masses.
We will now be able to bless the casket and place
the pall at the Baptismal Font.

Thirdly, we will be able to add more stations for
the distribution of Holy Communion in the center of
the church.

Also, moving the Font from its present location
creates an appropriate space for the image of Our
Lady of Guadalupe, Patroness of the Americas.

She can now be placed at the front of the church
for all to see, rather than hidden in the entrance
lobby.

A Reflection From Our Pastor

Dear Brothers and Sisters



I want to personally welcome everyone who attends Mass here this Christmas. The world is changed by the presence of a child, a baby, born in Bethlehem. The world is changed not because it magically becomes a better place, but because there is a presence of love which is able to transform, from within, all who receive it.

The child born is Son of God and son of Mary. As Son of God, he shows us that God is with us. As son of Mary, he shows that God is one with us. He has come to our world, the world which he created, and entered into it in

a way that only he could, becoming one with those he loved.

He asks for our love: so, he makes himself a child. God makes himself small so that we could understand him, welcome him, and love him.

We are able to love him precisely because he has loved us in this way. It's difficult to love someone who is strong, someone who we perceive as above us, greater than us, somebody we fear. It's much easier to love someone who is weak, defenseless, in need. Love descends to that person, that place, without effort, spontaneously.

The love which God has for us is a defenseless love. It is a love which will accept to be born in a cold stable. It is a love which will be placed in a wooden manger. It is a love which will, in the end, be beaten, stripped, humiliated. It is a love which will descend to the poorest and lowest experience of humanity. It is a love which, ultimately will allow itself to suffer in place of that humanity, to be crucified and buried in the ground. A love which will rise from the dead, from the ashes, from all hopelessness, and ascend to heaven, offering each one of us the possibility to experience the power which this love has to transform the world we live in.

This love redeems us from all that is not love, this love is able to penetrate the darkest night; but this love is no mere sweet sentimentality on God's part.

To receive it we ourselves are invited to become childlike, to become small. Brother Simeon, a Cistercian monk of St. Joseph's Abbey, puts it this way: "... a paradox is involved here: the greatness of God can be perceived only by babes, or infants, those who have no words of their own.... there is a clear affinity between God and children. This truth is at the center of the mystery of Christmas, when God is revealed in the form of a baby. If he loves the childlike, it is because they are empty enough to receive what he wants to give them."

We have come here to celebrate "Christmas," a word derived from "Christ's Mass." The Mass, our Eucharist, is our act of Thanksgiving in response to the love of God, for us and for all humanity.

This celebration belongs to all of us, and not just today, but every Sunday. You will find a welcoming parish community here, and a place to nourish your faith on a weekly basis. May each of us become child-like enough this Christmas to receive what Christ gives us. May his birth provoke a groundswell of reaction on our part, as we gather around him lying prostrate in the manger, may our lives and our world be transformed by this child born for us.

Una Reflexión de Nuestro Pastor

Queridos hermanos y hermanas



Quiero dar la bienvenida personalmente a todos los que asisten a la Misa aquí esta Navidad. El mundo ha cambiado por la presencia de un niño, un bebé, nacido en Belén. El mundo ha cambiado no porque se convierta mágicamente en un lugar mejor, sino porque hay una presencia de amor que es capaz de transformar, desde adentro, a todos los que lo reciben.

El niño nacido es Hijo de Dios e hijo de María. Como Hijo de Dios, nos muestra que Dios está con nosotros. Como hijo de María, muestra que Dios es uno con nosotros. Él ha venido a nuestro mundo, el mundo que él creó, y entró en él de una manera que solo él podía, convirtiéndose en uno con los que amaba.

Pide nuestro amor: así, se hace niño. Dios se hace pequeño para que podamos comprenderlo, acogerlo y amarlo.

Somos capaces de amarlo precisamente porque el nos ha amado de esta manera. Es difícil amar a alguien que es fuerte, alguien que percibimos como por encima de nosotros, más grande que nosotros, alguien a quien tememos. Es mucho más fácil amar a alguien débil, indefenso, necesitado. El amor desciende a esa persona, ese lugar, espontáneamente sin esfuerzo.

El amor que Dios tiene por nosotros es un amor indefenso. Es un amor que aceptará nacer en un establo frío. Es un amor que será colocado en un pesebre de madera. Es un amor que, al final, será golpeado, despojado, humillado. Es un amor que descenderá a la experiencia más pobre y más baja de la humanidad. Es un amor que, en última instancia, se permitirá sufrir en lugar de esta humanidad, para ser crucificado y enterrado en la tierra. Un amor que resucitará de entre los muertos, de las cenizas, de toda desesperanza, y ascenderá al cielo, ofreciéndonos a cada uno la posibilidad de experimentar el poder que este amor puede transformar el mundo en que vivimos.

Este amor nos redime de todo lo que no es amor, este amor es capaz de penetrar en la noche más oscura; pero este amor no es un simple y dulce sentimentalismo de parte de Dios.

Para recibirlo nosotros mismos estamos invitados a convertirnos en niños, a ser pequeños. El hermano Simeón, monje cisterciense de la abadía de St. Joseph, lo expresa así: "... una paradoja está involucrada aquí: la grandeza de Dios solo puede ser percibida por bebés, o infantes, aquellos que no tienen palabras propias... hay una clara afinidad entre Dios y los niños. Esta verdad está en el centro del misterio de la Navidad, cuando Dios se revela en forma de un bebé. Si ama a los niños, es porque están lo suficientemente vacíos para recibir lo que quiere darles."

Hemos venido aquí para celebrar la "Navidad", una palabra derivada de la "Misa de Cristo." La Misa, nuestra Eucaristía, es nuestro acto de acción de gracias en respuesta al amor de Dios, por nosotros y por toda la humanidad.

Esta celebración nos pertenece a todos, y no solo hoy, sino todos los domingos. Aquí encontrará una comunidad parroquial acogedora y un lugar para alimentar su fe semanalmente. Que cada uno de nosotros se vuelva lo suficientemente infantil esta Navidad para recibir lo que Cristo nos da. Que su nacimiento provoque una oleada de reacción de nuestra parte, mientras nos reunimos a su alrededor postrados en el pesebre, nuestras vidas y nuestro mundo sean transformados por este niño nacido para nosotros.




The bus will leave St. John's at 6am & return approximately at 10pm, with brief rest stops along the way. We ask for a donation of \$25 per person to help cover our costs.
