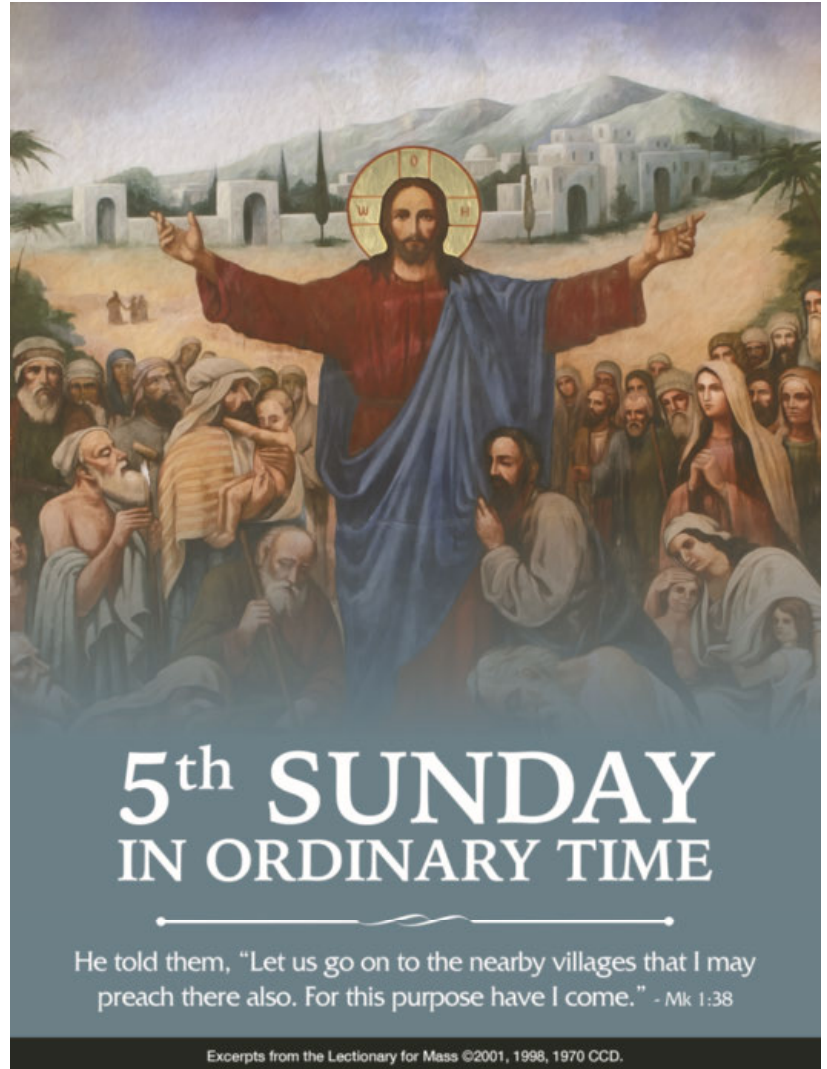

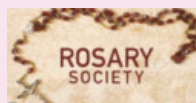

### A Reflection From Our Pastor

*Dear Brothers and Sisters,*



A young French doctor from Nantes made her several proposals of marriage. But no wedding ever took place. She declined. It was not to be.

The girl he wanted so much to marry had her heart set on a life of service to the sick. But that was not to be either. Why? Because she was far too sick herself!

She had chronic asthma, frequent chest pains, an aneurism and gastritis, a tumor on the knee leading to bone decay. Abscesses formed in both her ears, causing tinnitus and partial deafness.

In this terrible state she died. She was only 35 years old, and had been a nun for less than 12 years. Her name: Sister Marie Bernarde. We know her today as Saint Bernadette of Lourdes.

Lourdes is among the greatest places of healing in the world. But there was no miracle of healing for Bernadette. She lived with much suffering and pain. And she died with much suffering and pain.

Over five million pilgrims visit Lourdes every year, from all over the world. Perhaps you have been? Many pilgrims are sick, very sick. Some are incurable, including the dying. Some are old, some young.

Very few of these sick pilgrims are healed physically. The cancerous return home with their cancer. Paralytics return still paralyzed. Those with AIDS remain infected. Most of the blind do not see again.

Because the true miracle of Lourdes is not the healing of sick bodies - although this may happen. The true miracle of Lourdes is the healing that takes place within: true spiritual healing.

The healing ministry of the Church, at Lourdes, or indeed anywhere, even here in our parish, is not a substitute for proper medical treatment; nor is it an alternative to health insurance.

True healing takes place when every obstacle that prevents us from embracing our Cross is removed. This, ultimately, is the only form of healing that really matters. It is the most profound healing of all.

True healing brings a peace that cannot be destroyed by cancer, or by any other disease. True healing gives an experience of the love of God that no sickness can crush.

Faith is the real, lasting miracle of Lourdes. It is a moral miracle. And this is the healing that I need, and you need - a deep, inner healing.

Next Sunday, February 11th is the Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes. It is also the World Day of Prayer and Intercession for the Sick. In a message for this day, Pope Francis said:

"The sick, the vulnerable, and the poor are at the heart of the Church; they must also be at the heart of our human concern and pastoral attention. May we never forget this! And let us commend ourselves to Mary Most Holy, Health of the Sick, that she may intercede for us and help us to be artisans of closeness and fraternal relationships." *Rome, Saint John Lateran, 10 January 2024*

## Una Reflexión de Nuestro Pastor

*Queridos hermanos y hermanas,*



Un doctor joven frances de Nantes le hizo varias propuestas de matrimonio. Pero nunca hubo boda. Ella se negó. No pudo ser.

La chica con la que tanto quería casarse tenía el corazón puesto en una vida de servicio a los enfermos. Pero eso tampoco pudo ser. ¿Por qué? ¡Porque estaba demasiado enferma!

Tenía asma crónica, dolores frecuentes en el pecho, aneurisma y gastritis, un tumor en la rodilla causando una decadencia en los huesos. Abscesos formados en ambos oídos, causando tinnitus y sordera parcial.

En este terrible estado murió. Solo tenía 35 años y había sido monja menos de 12 años. Su nombre: Sor Marie Bernarde. Hoy la conocemos como Santa Bernardita de Lourdes.

Lourdes es uno de los lugares de sanación más grandes del mundo. Pero no hubo milagro de sanación para Bernadette. Vivió y murió con mucho sufrimiento y dolor.

Más de cinco millones de peregrinos visitan a Lourdes cada año, de todas partes del mundo. ¿Quizás usted ha hido? Muchos peregrinos están enfermos, muy enfermos. Algunos son incurables, incluyendo los moribundos. Algunos son viejos, algunos jóvenes.

Muy pocos de estos peregrinos enfermos son sanados físicamente. Los cancerosos regresan a casa con su cáncer. Los paralíticos regresan todavía paralizados. Las personas con SIDA siguen infectadas. La mayoría de los ciegos no vuelven a ver.

Porque el verdadero milagro de Lourdes no es la sanación de cuerpos enfermos - aunque esto puede suceder. El verdadero milagro de Lourdes es la sanación que tiene lugar en su interior: la verdadera sanación espiritual.

El ministerio de sanidad de la Iglesia, en Lourdes, o en cualquier otro lugar, incluso aquí en nuestra parroquia, no es un sustituto para el tratamiento médico adecuado; ni es una alternativa al seguro de salud.

La verdadera sanación tiene lugar cuando se elimina todo obstáculo que nos impide abrazar nuestra Cruz. Esta, en última instancia, es la única forma de sanación que realmente importa. Es la sanación más profunda de todas.

La verdadera sanidad trae una paz que no puede ser destruida por el cáncer, o por cualquier otra enfermedad. La verdadera sanidad es una experiencia del amor de Dios que ninguna enfermedad puede aplastar.

La fe es el verdadero y duradero milagro de Lourdes. Es un milagro moral. Y esta es la sanación que yo necesito, y tú necesitas - una profunda sanación interior.

El próximo domingo, 11 de febrero, es la Solemnidad de Nuestra Señora de Lourdes. Es también la Jornada mundial de oración e intercesión por los enfermos. En un mensaje para este día, el Papa Francisco dijo:

"Los enfermos, los vulnerables y los pobres están en el corazón de la Iglesia; también deben estar en el centro de nuestra atención humana y pastoral. ¡Que nunca olvidemos esto! Y encomendémonos a María Santísima, Salud de los enfermos, para que interceda por nosotros y nos ayude a ser instrumentos de cercanía y de relaciones fraternas."

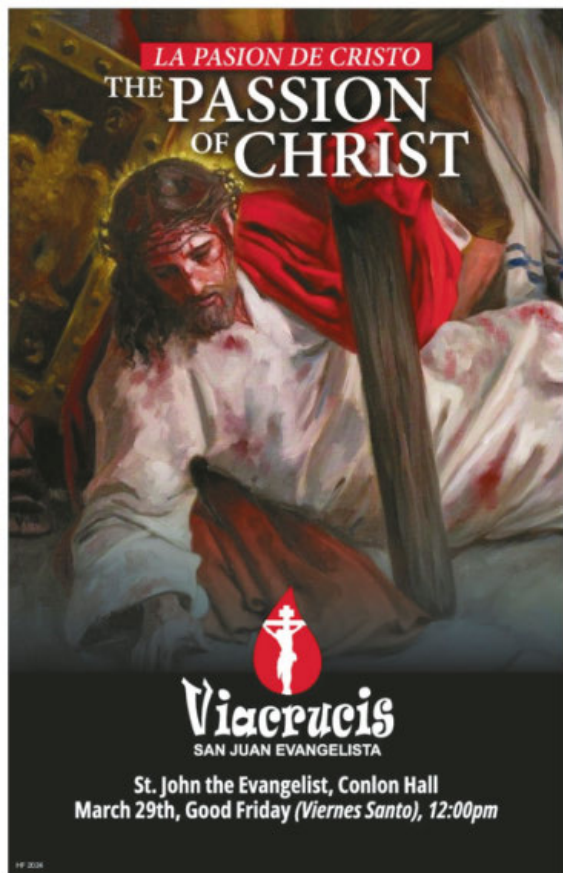

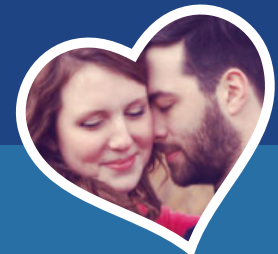
