





A Reflection From Our Pastor

Dear Brothers and Sisters,



While they were speaking about this, he stood in their midst and said to them, "Peace be with you."

The disciples were speaking about Jesus, and about what had occurred in Jerusalem. They were talking about the Last Supper, about the night in the garden of Gethsemane, about the betrayal, about the farce of a trial, the Passion and the Crucifixion, and about how Jesus had appeared to two of them on the road to Emmaus.

Their conversation was about all these things, the things they had experienced. Of course they were talking about these things, they are disciples, that's what they are supposed to talk about.

Truth is people don't usually talk about these things.

People talk about the weather, sports, politics, the stock market, the price of gas, our job, our school, our vacations, our pets, our plans for the summer...but conversation about Holy Week and Easter is probably not part of our daily interactions.

A couple of years ago I was invited to a family dinner on Easter Sunday. There were at least twenty people around the table. During the course of the meal, the host invited everyone present to say a word about their experience of Easter. I was surprised that those at table did not just say "I liked this" or "I liked that."

People began to speak existentially. That is, they began to speak about how they had lived Easter, saying how and in which way they had experienced God in Holy Week and the Triduum. In speaking about these things, I could sense that God became present at that table.

The Fathers of the Church said that a meal in which God is not mentioned is like a pagan sacrifice. To sit down and eat without mentioning God is like sacrificing to idols.

That thought brought back memories of my childhood, when it would have been unthinkable to sit down as a family to eat without at least saying a prayer together first –grace before meals.


The word and the breaking of bread. These two things make those at table experience communion. While we speak of these things Jesus himself comes to stand in our midst. The disciples were talking about all these things when Jesus himself came and stood in their midst.

The same Jesus who was crucified and died, and who is now Risen, is able to come and stand in our midst today. He appeared to the disciples at Emmaus when they sat down to break bread. He appeared to the disciples in Jerusalem as they were talking about these things. The risen Jesus Christ can be a guest in our home and at our table today. What will you talk about at lunch today?

Una Reflexión de Nuestro Pastor

Queridos hermanos y hermanas,



Mientras estaban hablando de todo esto, Jesús se presentó en medio de ellos y les dijo: "Paz a ustedes."

Los discípulos hablaban de Jesús y de lo que había ocurrido en Jerusalén. Hablaban de la Última Cena, de la noche en el huerto de Getsemani, de la traición, de la farsa de un juicio, de la Pasión y de la Crucifixión, y de cómo Jesús se les había aparecido a dos de ellos en el camino a Emaús.

Su conversación era sobre todas estas cosas, las cosas que habían experimentado. Por supuesto que estaban hablando de estas cosas, son discípulos, de eso se supone que deben hablar. La verdad es que la gente no suele hablar de estas cosas.

La gente habla del clima, los deportes, la política, la bolsa de valores, el precio del gas, nuestro trabajo, nuestra escuela, nuestras vacaciones, nuestras mascotas, nuestros planes para el verano... pero la conversación sobre Semana Santa y Pascua probablemente no es parte de nuestras interacciones diarias.

Hace un par de años fui invitado a una cena familiar el domingo de Pascua. Había al menos veinte personas alrededor de la mesa. Durante el transcurso de la comida, el anfitrión invitó a todos los presentes a decir unas palabras sobre su experiencia de la Pascua. Me sorprendió que los que estaban en la mesa no solo dijeran "me gustó esto" o "me gustó eso."

La gente comenzó a hablar existencialmente. Es decir, comenzaron a hablar de cómo habían vivido la Pascua, diciendo cómo y de qué manera habían experimentado a Dios en la Semana Santa y el Triduo Pascual. Al hablar de estas cosas, pude sentir que Dios se hizo presente en esa mesa.

Los Padres de la Iglesia dijeron que una comida en la que no se menciona a Dios es como un sacrificio pagano. Sentarse y comer sin mencionar a Dios es como sacrificar a los ídolos.

Ese pensamiento me trajo recuerdos de mi infancia, cuando hubiera sido incomprensible sentarme con una familia a comer sin al menos rezar juntos en acción de gracias por la comida.

La palabra y la fracción del pan. Estas dos cosas hacen que los que están en la mesa experimenten la comunión. Mientras hablamos de estas cosas, Jesús mismo viene a estar entre nosotros. Los discípulos estaban hablando de todas estas cosas cuando Jesús mismo vino y se puso en medio de ellos.

El mismo Jesús que fue crucificado y murió, y que ahora ha resucitado, puede venir y estar entre nosotros hoy. Se apareció a los discípulos en Emaús cuando se sentaron a partir el pan. Se apareció a los discípulos en Jerusalén mientras hablaban de estas cosas. El Jesucristo resucitado puede ser un invitado en nuestra casa y en nuestra mesa hoy. ¿De qué hablarán hoy en el almuerzo?
