

A Reflection From Our Pastor

Dear Brothers and Sisters,



"I am the good shepherd. A good shepherd lays down his life for his sheep"

Sheep and were a common sight where I grew up in Wales. White specks against green grass; dotted over the mountainsides and valleys.

The imagery of sheep and shepherds used to be common to everyone of faith, no matter which country they lived in. Whereas today, on entering a church, we are accustomed to see the crucifix, prior to the third century -when the image of Christ on the Cross became the essential symbol of Christianity- the Savior was represented in Christian art, and in the prayers of the first generations of believers, as a young shepherd.

In his book "The Burning Bush" Lev Gillet, a monk of the Orthodox Church, gives a meditation on what is perhaps the most popular of all Psalms, the "Shepherd Psalm, Psalm 23". He says:

'There is no doubt that Jesus, when he spoke of the good shepherd, had the twenty-third psalm in mind. He himself had certainly recited it, and knew it even as a small child':

"The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want"

This is not a forecast of the future: 'the Lord will be my shepherd'

This is not a wishful prayer: 'Lord, be my shepherd'

It is a statement of fact: 'The Lord is my shepherd'

The Lord is not any kind of shepherd. He is not a shepherd in an abstract or general sense. He is not shepherd of the flock as a flock. He is not 'our shepherd'. Or rather he is our shepherd, but he is also something else and something more. He is my Shepherd.'

Jesus, the Good Shepherd, lays down his life for his sheep.

I was once in Corsica -a French island in the Mediterranean- and was shown the sheep folds which shepherds use to gather the flock at night. A round circle of stones, shoulder high, with an opening through which the sheep enter or leave the enclosure. But there was no door or gate at the opening. The shepherd himself lies down there at night. He is the door; he is the gate. A wolf would have to kill him before getting at the sheep. No one goes in or out except through him. As psalm 121 says: He does not sleep, he guards your going in and out, now and for always.

Only in the measure we discover this are we then able to say 'I lack nothing'. Translated, if I am lacking something today, if there is something missing in my life, it is because the Lord is not my shepherd, my 'going in and out' is not through him, I am not listening to his voice, I am not following him.

The Good News is that the Good Shepherd will speak to us in the Liturgy today. He invites us to listen to His voice, that our going in and out may be through Him. Together with the psalmist may each of us be able to say: it is true, he is my shepherd, I lack nothing.

Una Reflexión de Nuestro Pastor

Queridos hermanos y hermanas,



"Yo soy el buen pastor. El buen pastor da su vida por las ovejas"

Ovejas y eran una vista común donde crecí en Gales. Manchas blancas contra la hierba verde; salpicadas sobre las laderas de las montañas y los valles.

Las imágenes de ovejas y pastores solían ser comunes a todos los creyentes, sin importar en qué país vivieran. Considerando que hoy, al entrar en una iglesia, estamos acostumbrados a ver el crucifijo, antes del siglo III -cuando

la imagen de Cristo en la cruz se convirtió en el símbolo esencial del cristianismo- el Salvador fue representado en el arte cristiano, y en las oraciones de las primeras generaciones de creyentes, como un joven pastor.

En su libro "La zarza ardiente" Lev Gillet, un monje de la Iglesia ortodoxa, da una meditación sobre lo que es quizás el más popular de todos los Salmos, el "Salmo del Pastor, Salmo 23". Él dice que:

'No hay duda de que Jesús, cuando habló del buen pastor, tenía en mente el salmo veintitrés. Él mismo ciertamente lo había recitado, y lo sabía incluso desde que era un niño'.

"El Señor es mi pastor; nada me falta"

Esto no es un pronóstico del futuro: 'el Señor será mi pastor'

Esta no es una oración de deseo: 'Señor, sé mi pastor'

Es una declaración de hecho: 'El Señor es mi pastor'

El Señor no es ningún tipo de pastor. No es un pastor en un sentido abstracto o general. No es pastor del rebaño como un rebaño. Él no es 'nuestro pastor'. O más bien es nuestro pastor, pero también es algo más y algo más. Él es mi Pastor.'

Jesús, el Buen Pastor, da su vida por sus ovejas.

Una vez estuve en Córcega -una isla francesa en el Mediterráneo- y me mostraron los rebaños de ovejas que los pastores usan para reunir al rebaño por la noche. Un círculo redondo de piedras, alto en el hombro, con una abertura a través de la cual las ovejas entran o salen del recinto. Pero no había puerta ni portón en la apertura. El pastor mismo se acuesta allí por la noche. Él es la puerta; él es la reja. Un lobo tendría que matarlo antes de llegar a las ovejas. Nadie entra o sale excepto a través de él. Como dice el salmo 121: Él no duerme, él te guarda al salir y regresar ahora y para siempre.

Solo en la medida en que descubrimos esto somos capaces de decir 'no me falta nada'. Traducido, si me falta algo hoy, si falta algo en mi vida, es porque el Señor no es mi pastor, mi 'entrar y salir' no es a través de él, no estoy escuchando su voz, No lo estoy siguiendo.

La Buena Nueva es que el Buen Pastor nos hablará hoy en la Liturgia. Nos invita a escuchar su voz, para que nuestra entrada y salida sea a través de él. Juntamente con el salmista, cada uno de nosotros puede decir: es verdad, él es mi pastor, nada me falta.
