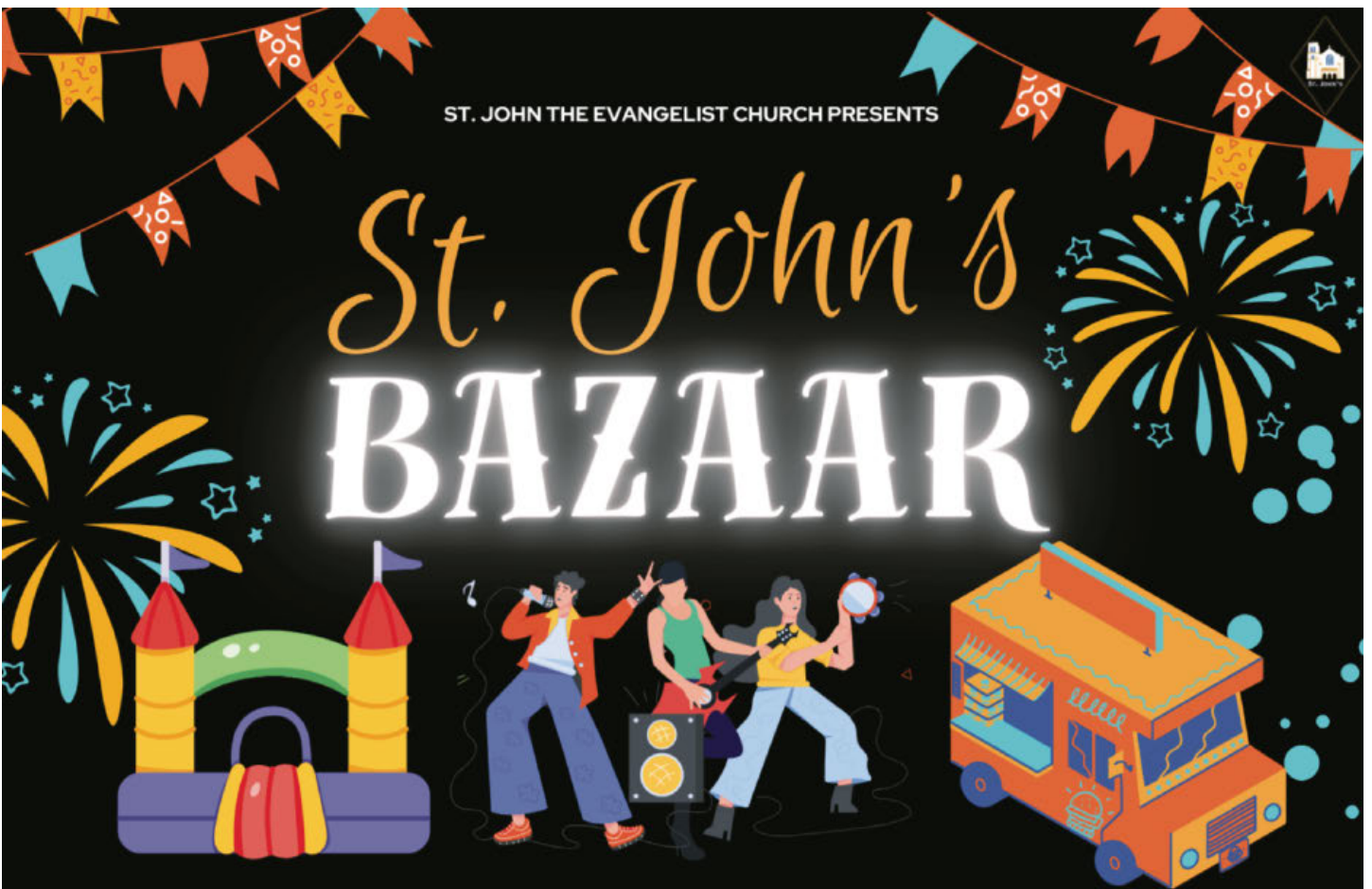

Baptism

Please call the rectory at 201-384-0101 to schedule your baptism and confirm your attendance at the instructional meeting.

The **Parent Instructional** meeting is held the **1st Sunday of the month at 1:30 PM** and the **3rd Sunday at 2:45 PM in Spanish**.

Baptisms are held the **2nd & 3rd Sundays of the month at 3 PM in English** and the **4th Sunday of the month at 2:45 PM in Spanish**.

Parents **must** be registered parishioners and provide the child's birth certificate, and have godparents who are **practicing Catholics**.

Godparents need to be at least sixteen, confirmed, received the Eucharist, and if married, have the Sacrament of Matrimony.

A sponsor certificate, **for each Godparent**, must be provided a week prior to the baptism.

"Two hundred days' wages worth of food would not be enough for each of them to have a little."

In today's Gospel, the Apostles are given the monumental task of finding food in the middle of nowhere in order to feed the crowd of five thousand people. As you'd expect, none of the Apostles - or

anyone in the crowd for that matter - were able to provide a solution to this problem. Once it's been established that nobody has an answer, Jesus steps up and multiplies the fish and loaves presented by a boy in the crowd. This small offering fed the five thousand people.

What would've taken "two hundred days' wages worth of food", Jesus Christ provides in an instant. And what a stir it caused! They wanted to make him king, right then and there! This impulse, however, didn't stem from faith. They didn't see Jesus as the Son of God. They saw him as the Bread King - the one who could fill their bellies, the one who could solve their problems with the Romans, with unreasonable taxes, with the lack of food and the overwhelming number of sick, etc.

Perhaps we see Jesus more as the Bread King - or the Burger King, the Money King, the Medicine King - instead of seeing him as the Son of God.

Jesus never identified himself as the Bread King - he never identified himself as the one to solve all our problems. He came as the Son of God, offering not merely full bellies, but new hearts.

Growing up, I thought Jesus was supposed to be a Bread King. And I thought he was a really bad one, because my family was poor. I didn't accept having to work at 13 years old to pay for school while my friends had the luxury of laying around because their parents' were wealthy. I thought the Bread King needed to fix my problems. I often prayed that he would. And he didn't.

I'm happy he didn't appear to me as the Bread King. Jesus was trying to show me that he's the Son of God and can do a much bigger miracle than filling my belly or paying for my school: he wanted to give me a full heart.

Today, we can either *work for the bread of this earth* or *wait for the Bread come down from Heaven*. We can either *look for the Bread King* or *welcome the Son of God*. One fills the belly while the other fills the heart. What do you want?

En el Evangelio de hoy, los Apóstoles se enfrentan a la desafiante tarea de proveer comida para una multitud de cinco mil personas en medio de la nada. A pesar de la incertidumbre inicial, Jesús interviene y transforma los peces y panes de un niño en una generosa provisión que sacia a todos.

Lo que Jesucristo proporciona en un instante es más que lo que habría requerido "el equivalente a doscientos días de salario en alimentos". ¡Y qué revuelo causó! ¡Querían hacerlo rey, en ese mismo momento! Sin embargo, este impulso no surgió de la fe. No vieron a Jesús como el Hijo de Dios. Lo veían como el Rey del Pan, el que podía llenar sus barrigas, el que podía resolver sus problemas con los romanos, con los impuestos irrazonables, con la falta de comida y la abrumadora cantidad de enfermos, etc.

Quizás podamos ver a Jesús más como el Monarca del Pan -o el Burger King, el Monarca del Dinero, el Monarca de la Medicina- en lugar de verlo como el Hijo de Dios.

Jesús nunca se presentó como el Monarca del Pan; nunca se presentó como quien resolvería todos nuestros problemas. Vino como el Hijo de Dios, ofreciendo no solo vientres llenos, sino corazones nuevos.

Al crecer, creía que Jesús era el Rey del Pan. Me parecía injusto, ya que éramos una familia pobre. No entendía por qué a los 13 años tenía que trabajar para pagar la escuela mientras mis amigos disfrutaban de la holgazanería gracias a la riqueza de sus padres. Pensaba que el Rey del Pan debía resolver mis problemas y solía rezar por ello. Sin embargo, eso nunca sucedió.

Me llena de alegría no haberme presentado como el Rey del Pan. Jesús quería demostrarme que es el Hijo de Dios y puede realizar un milagro mucho más grande que saciar mi hambre o pagar mis estudios: buscaba colmar mi corazón.

Hoy es el día para trabajar por el pan de esta tierra o aguardar que el Pan descienda del Cielo. Busquemos al Rey del Pan o demos la bienvenida al Hijo de Dios. Uno sacia el vientre, el otro colma el corazón. ¿Cuál eliges?
