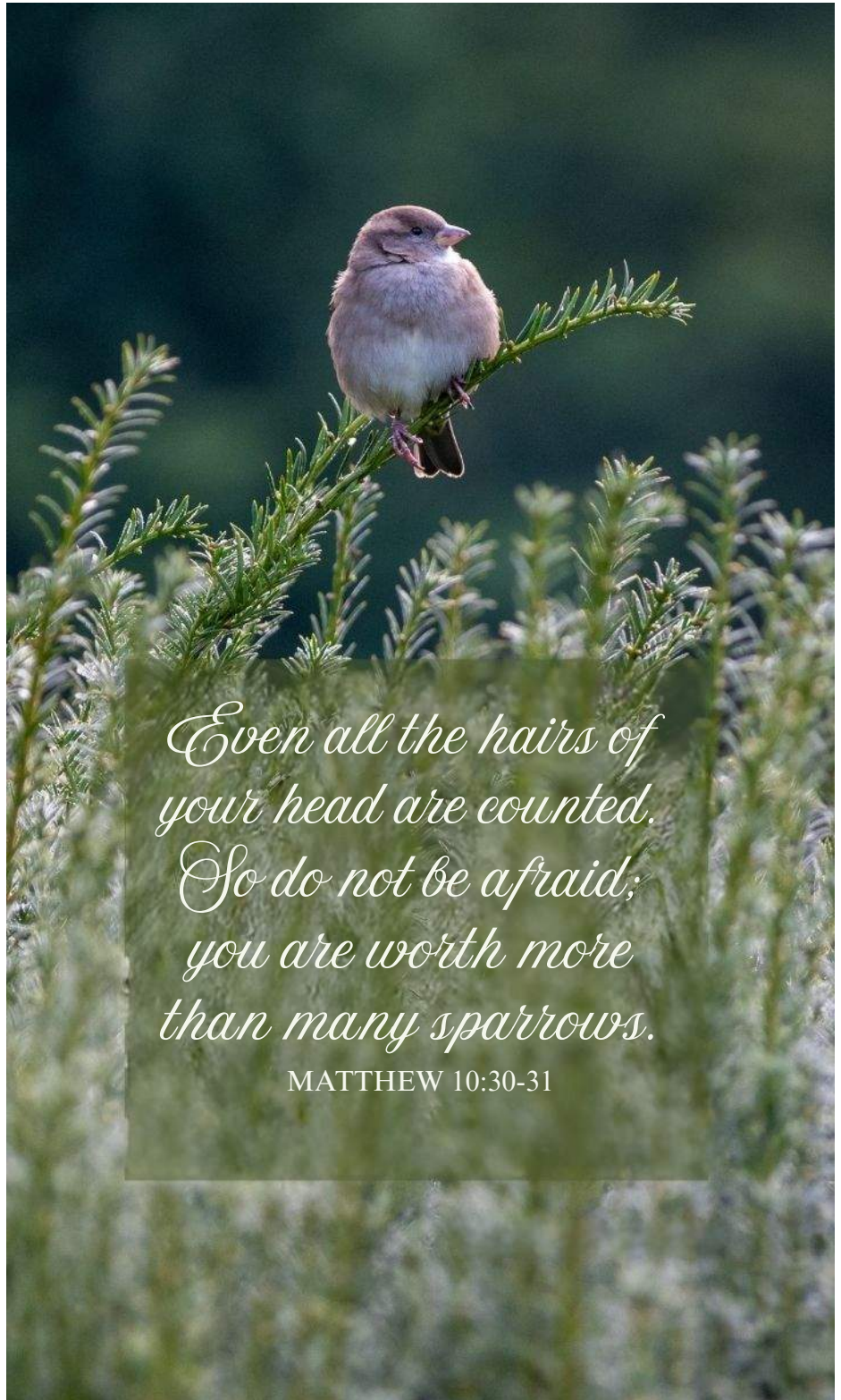

Dear Brothers and Sisters



One was a Bishop, the other the Lord Chancellor. Both incurred the wrath of someone who was more powerful than both of them.

Bishop John Fisher and Thomas More were martyred on Tower Hill, just outside the Tower of London, in front of huge crowds who had come to witness the spectacle. Bishop John was martyred on June 22 1535, and Thomas two weeks later on July 6.

Their crime? The defense of marriage. Not any marriage, but that of the king, Henry VIII.

John Fisher was the only bishop to oppose the King and yet he avoided confrontation with his fellow bishops. Rather, he said of them:

“I condemn no other man’s conscience: their conscience may save them, and mine must save me. We should remember, in all the controversies in which we engage, to treat our opponents as if they were acting in good faith, even if they seem to us to be acting out of spite or self-interest”.

Thomas More wrote his best devotional works while imprisoned awaiting execution, including - A Prayer for Our Enemies:

“Almighty God, have mercy on **N.** and **N.**, and on all that bear me evil will, and would me harm. Their faults and mine together, by such easy, tender, merciful means as thine infinite wisdom best can devise, vouchsafe to amend and redress; and make us saved souls in Heaven together, where we may ever live and love together with thee and thy blessed saints, O glorious Trinity, for the bitter passion of our sweet Saviour Christ. Amen”.

Lord, give me patience in tribulation and grace in everything, to conform my will to thine, that I may truly say: “Fiat voluntas tua, duct in caelo et in terra.” (May your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven). The things, good Lord, that I pray for, give me thy grace to labour for. Amen”.
(St. Thomas More 1477-1535).

The feast day for Saints John Fisher and Thomas More is this Monday June 22. Pray for Us.

Highlights from Cardinal Tobin's Recent Letter on "We Are His Witnesses"

On the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, the Archdiocese of Newark is entering a new phase of its "We Are His Witnesses" pastoral initiative. Inspired by Pope Francis' call for pastoral conversion, this effort invites our community to transition from maintaining our current structures to becoming a dynamic, outward-looking Church rooted in Christ's love.

Key Highlights:

- **Listening to the Faithful:** Feedback from recent listening sessions revealed a deep love for our parishes and a profound desire to learn how to evangelize and welcome back families, youth, and those who have fallen away.
- **Parish Mission Partners:** Recognizing that no parish can carry Christ's mission alone, neighboring communities will partner to pray, reflect, and collaborate on shared ministries, outreach, and long-term sustainability.
- **Discerning the Future Together:** This journey of synodality recognizes that renewal begins in the heart. While some partnerships may lead to mergers, the goal is to preserve each community's unique culture and spiritual gifts while strengthening the wider Church.
- **The Path Forward:** Twelve pilot parishes will lead the way through December 2026. This fall, regional meetings will prepare all pastors and leaders for this next phase of shared prayer, participation, and collaborative ministry.

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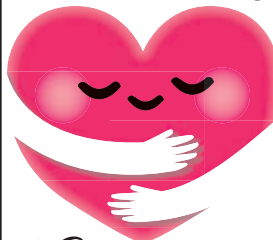
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
