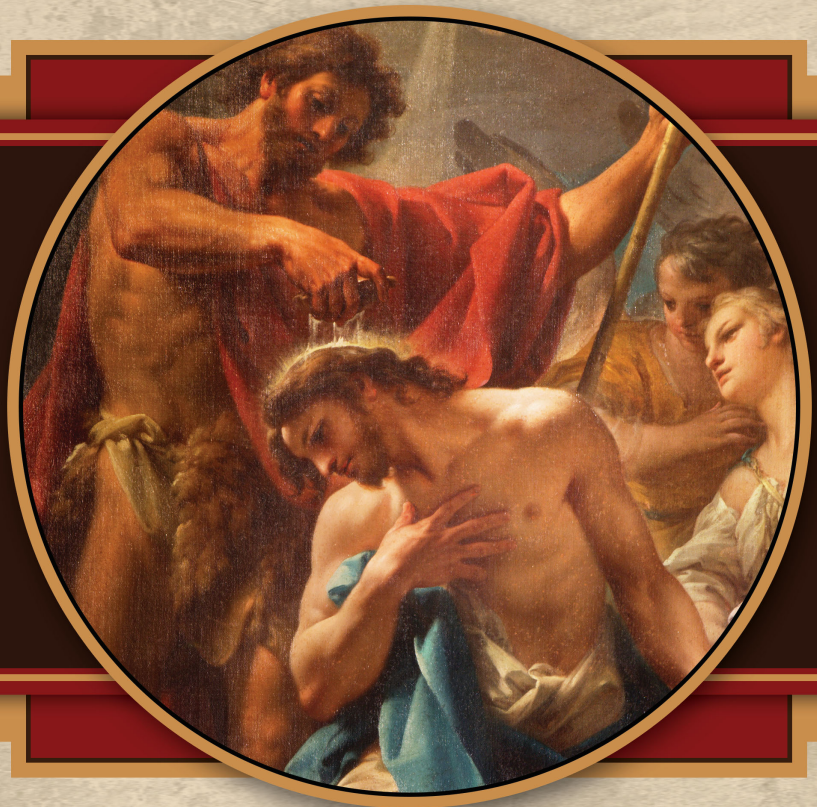

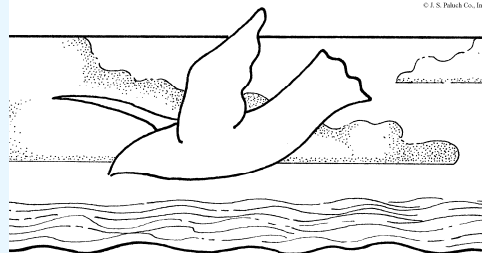

BAPTISMAL DEATH AND RESURRECTION

As we celebrate the Baptism of the Lord, we also honor our own baptism as our initiation into the Christian life and community. In the Gospel, the baptism of Jesus, with his immersion and then emergence from the water, points to his later submission to God at his death, and his emergence from the grave at his resurrection. This pattern of death and resurrection is our path too, as followers of Jesus. Throughout life, often in small ways, we learn to surrender our limited and self-centered agendas. This surrender often feels like death. The sacrament of Baptism ritually enacts this pattern to remind us of Jesus' death and resurrection, so that we too might embrace the deaths and resurrections of our own lives. As Jesus emerged from the water, he encountered his Father and the Holy Spirit. Like Jesus, we can know we are God's beloved, empowered by the Spirit. *Copyright © J. S. Paluch Co.*

Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners,

This weekend we observe the Baptism of Our Lord. Although Jesus did not need to be baptized, He made baptism spiritually life-giving and sin-forgiving for anyone who would believe in Him and follow the way of life He offers. He gives us His Grace each day to reject sin and to put our Faith into action. I invite you to pray in a special way for all those who were baptized in our church last year or who will be this year, that they and their families may be faithful followers!

Families planning to baptize their babies should contact one of the priests or deacons at the rectory to begin the registration process. We would need a copy of the child's birth certificate. Other details, including preparation for first-time parents, will be explained during registration. Only those aged 16 or older, who have received their own sacraments of Baptism, Communion, and Confirmation (and the Sacrament of Matrimony if married), may serve as godparents.

Older children, teenagers, and adults who were not baptized as infants may also prepare for this Sacrament through adapted programs of the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults. Those under 18 should contact Rosemarie Flood or Deacon Airán at the Religious Education Office. Those 18 and older should contact Deacon Jim or Deacon Airán.

Reflection on Today's Scripture Readings

This is one of the key moments in the life of Jesus. Up north in his hometown of Nazareth he must have heard about John. At some point an inner voice must have said, "Go south, go to the desert. Go listen to this preacher John."

When he came to the desert, he may have stood in a long line before that moment came when he entered the water and John baptized him. Mark gives us only the briefest account of their meeting, but does present John as expecting someone mightier than he who would baptize with the Holy Spirit.

It is this same Holy Spirit who came down on Jesus as he was coming out of the water. At that moment, the heavens were torn open, heaven reached down to touch the Galilean, and the Spirit descended like a dove. Have you ever seen a gull descend to snatch a fish or a hawk swoop down to seize its prey? By contrast, the image of a descending dove is one of beauty and grace, of gentle alighting.

The words do not announce Jesus to others, as in Matthew's account, but they are spoken only to him: "You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased" (1:11), echoing the words the Lord speaks in the first song of the Servant in the book of Isaiah.

The descent of the dove did not mean an easy life for Jesus, but God had penetrated his being in a way that would then drive him into the desert to begin his mission of confronting the powers of sin and death. Este fin de semana celebramos el Bautismo de Nuestro Señor. Aunque Jesús no necesitaba ser bautizado, hizo del bautismo espiritualmente vivificante y perdonador de pecados para cualquiera que crea en Él y siga el camino de vida que Él ofrece. Él nos da Su Gracia cada día para rechazar el pecado y poner nuestra Fe en acción. Los invito a orar de manera especial por todos aquellos que fueron bautizados en nuestra iglesia el año pasado o que lo serán este año, ¡para que ellos y sus familias sean fieles seguidores!

Las familias que planean bautizar a sus bebés deben comunicarse con uno de los sacerdotes o diáconos en la rectoría para comenzar el proceso de registro. Necesitaríamos una copia del acto de nacimiento del bebé. Otros detalles, incluida la preparación para padres primerizos, se explicarán durante el registro. Solo aquellos de 16 años o más, que hayan recibido sus propios sacramentos de Bautismo, Comunión y Confirmación (y el Sacramento del Matrimonio si están casados), pueden servir como padrinos.

Los niños mayores, adolescentes y adultos que no fueron bautizados cuando eran bebés también pueden prepararse para este Sacramento a través de programas adaptados del Rito de Iniciación Cristiana para Adultos. Los menores de 18 años deben comunicarse con Rosemarie Flood o el Diácono Airán en la Oficina de Educación Religiosa. Los mayores de 18 años deben comunicarse con el Diácono Jim o el Diácono Airán.

Reflexión de las Escrituras de Hoy

Éste es uno de los momentos clave en la vida de Jesús. En su propia ciudad de Nazaret, ubicada al norte, él debió haber oído hablar de Juan. En algún momento debió haber escuchado una voz interior que le decía: “Dirígete hacia el sur, ve al desierto. Ve a escuchar a este predicador Juan”.

Cuando llegó al desierto es probable que haya estado esperando en una larga fila antes de que llegara el momento de entrar en el agua y que Juan lo bautizara. Marcos nos hace sólo un recuento brevísimo de tal encuentro, pero nos describe a Juan como esperando a alguien más poderoso que él, que bautizará con el Espíritu Santo.

Es este mismo Espíritu Santo que descendió sobre Jesús en cuanto salió del agua. En ese momento se abrieron los cielos, el cielo bajó a tocar al galileo y el Espíritu bajó sobre él como una paloma. ¿Has visto alguna vez una gaviota descender para arrebatar un pez o a un halcón precipitarse de picada para agarrar su presa? En contraste, una paloma que desciende es una imagen de belleza y gracia, y de posarse suavemente.

Las palabras de hoy no anuncian a Cristo a los demás, como sucede en la versión de Mateo, sino que se enuncian sólo para Jesús: “Tú eres mi Hijo amado, en ti me complazco” (1:11), haciendo eco de las palabras que el Señor dice en el primer cántico del Siervo en el libro de Isaías.

El descenso de la paloma no quiso significar una vida fácil para Jesús, sino más bien que Dios había penetrado el ser de Jesús de tal manera que lo llevaría hasta el desierto para comenzar su misión de confrontar los poderes del pecado y de la muerte. 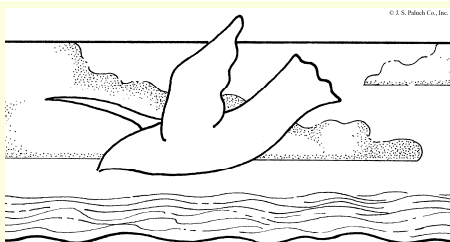
