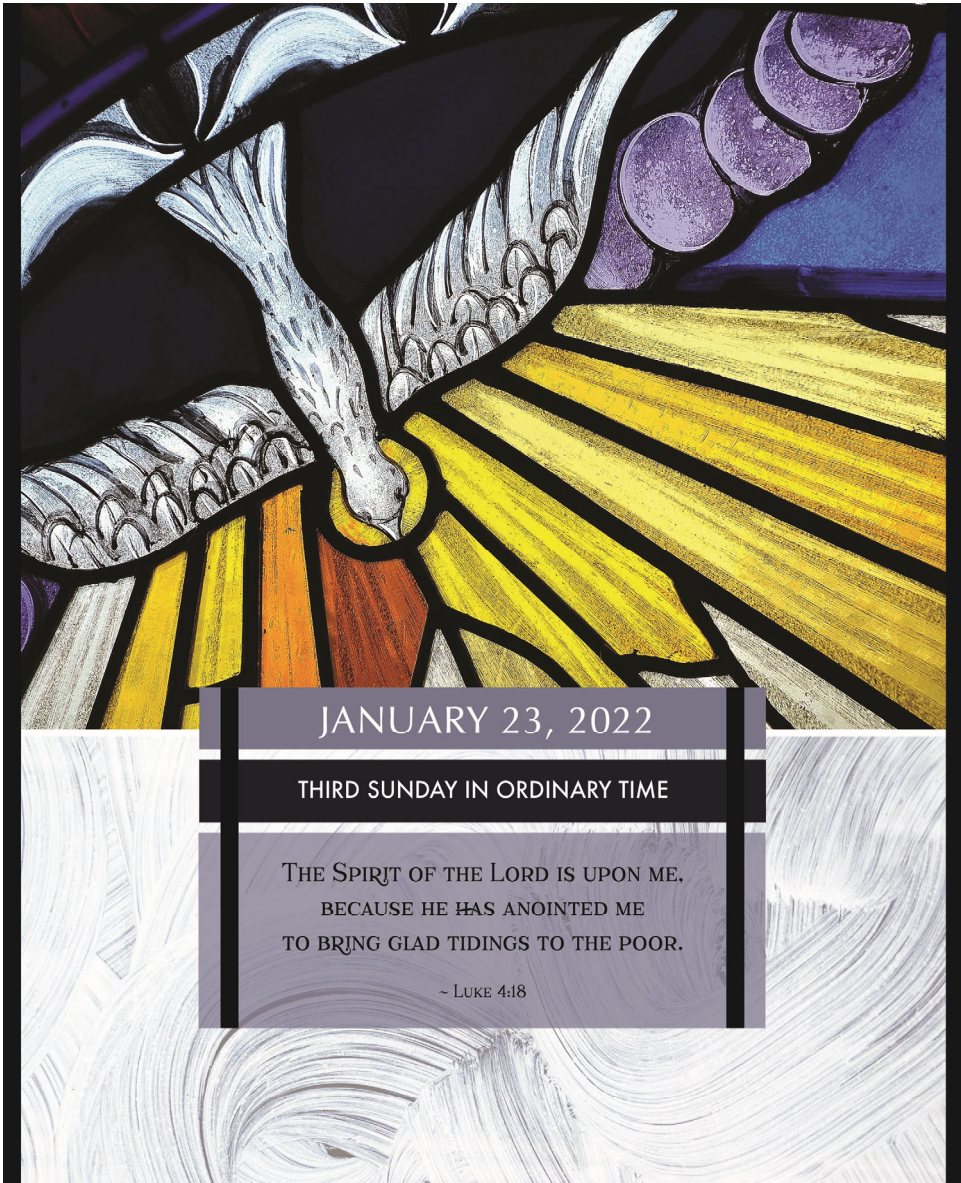

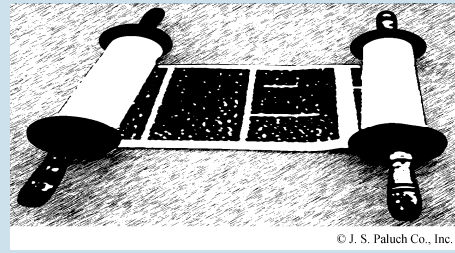

GOD'S LAW

Scripture has always held God's law to be the path to human happiness. In today's first reading, Ezra the priest reads the scroll of the law to the people returned from exile. They weep—then are joyful. Israel's relationship with God had always been defined by how they kept and lived God's law. The author of Psalm 96 likewise praises the law of God as the source of wisdom, joy & enlightenment, purity and justice.

In his advice to the bickering Corinthians, Paul points out that, just as God has made all parts of a human body essential for the health of the whole, living as "Christ's body" requires that each member be recognized as necessary for the good of all. Finally, in Luke's Gospel Jesus claims that the Spirit is sending him to relieve human suffering. Like Ezra, he is reading from a scroll, proclaiming God's "law" of mercy to those in need.

Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners,

Today is In-Pew Commitment Sunday for the Annual Appeal. Most of you should have received a brochure and pledge envelope in the mail, and may return it directly to the Archdiocese. If you have not, you have the opportunity today. Our goal is the same as last year, \$104,591.00, which we significantly surpassed last year with pledges of \$121,826.00 and payments of \$116,202.00. What is different this year is the preference that all pledges at least be made before June 30 and ideally paid off by June 30 if that is at all possible. You may still extend payments through December if that is easier on your budget.

Given the ongoing omicron issues as well as wintry weather, Cardinal Tobin has suggested that we postpone our Synod survey and listening sessions until February and March, so that we might be able to get more people involved. We will continue to provide some background each week. These sessions may not solve all the problems or limitations in our Church today, but surely, they will shed light on which direction the Church needs to move forward in these changing times. The reflection will include both things we are doing and might do here in our parish, as well as more general areas that the Church as a whole needs to consider. In the meantime, continue to pray the Synod prayer each day, asking the Holy Spirit to guide us all!

Reflection on Today's Scripture Readings

The book of Isaiah has been called the fifth Gospel, so often do the Gospel writers use it for proclaiming Jesus as Christ, the long-awaited Messiah and Son of God. In today's Gospel reading, Jesus begins to move through his home territory of Galilee "in the power of the Spirit" (Luke 4:14), the same Spirit that descended on him after his baptism. He then goes to his hometown of Nazareth and to the synagogue on the Sabbath.

A hush must have filled the room as he walked to the place of reading and searched the scroll to find this passage. They had been hearing about his time in Galilee and how all had praised his teaching. What would he say to them? He chose Isaiah's words (61:1-2a) about one anointed by the Spirit who would preach good news to the poor, bring liberty to captives, and, at the heart of these lines, exercise a ministry of compassion, a reference to another citation from Isaiah (see 42:6b).

This three-part mission continues to be the work of the Church: preaching the Gospel, working for social justice, and reaching out to all peoples in compassion. At the beginning of his ministry, Jesus announced that this work was being fulfilled in the hearing of his listeners by what he was doing. The Spirit works to do the same today through us. —James A. Estimados Feligreses,

Hoy Domingo es nuestro Compromiso del Llamado Anual de nuestra Arquidiócesis. Seguramente algunos de ustedes han recibido un folleto con sobres por correo, y pueden devolverlo directamente a la Arquidiócesis. Si no han recibido los sobres y folletos, hoy tienen la oportunidad de obtenerlos. Nuestra meta es la misma que la del año pasado, \$104,591.00, la cual superamos significativamente el año pasado con compromisos de \$121,826.00 y pagos de \$116,202.00. Lo que es diferente este año es la preferencia de que todas las promesas se realicen al menos antes del 30 de junio y, de ser posible, se paguen antes del 30 de junio. Todavía puede extender los pagos hasta diciembre si eso es más fácil para su presupuesto.

Dados los problemas actuales de ómicron, así como el clima invernal, el Cardenal Tobin ha sugerido que pospongamos nuestras sesiones de encuesta y escucha del Sínodo hasta febrero y marzo, para que podamos involucrar a más personas. Continuaremos proporcionando algunos antecedentes cada semana. Es posible que estas sesiones no resuelvan todos los problemas o limitaciones de nuestra Iglesia hoy día, pero seguramente arrojarán luz sobre la dirección en la que la Iglesia debe avanzar en estos tiempos cambiantes. La reflexión incluirá tanto las cosas que estamos haciendo y las que podríamos hacer aquí en nuestra parroquia, como áreas más generales que la Iglesia en su conjunto debe considerar. Mientras tanto, continúen rezando la oración del Sínodo cada día, ¡pidiendo al Espíritu Santo que nos guíe a todos!

Reflexión de las Escrituras de Hoy

Al libro de Isaías se le ha llamado el quinto Evangelio debido a lo frecuente que los evangelistas se refieren al mismo para proclamar que Jesús es el Cristo, el tan esperado Mesías, el Hijo de Dios. En la lectura del Evangelio de hoy Jesús comienza a moverse por todo el territorio de su tierra natal, Galilea, “lleno de la fuerza del Espíritu” (Lucas 4:14), el mismo Espíritu que descendió sobre él después de su bautismo. Luego va a Nazaret, donde se había criado, y allí visita la sinagoga el sábado.

Un silencio debió haber cundido por todo el salón al dirigirse al lugar de leer y desenrollar el libro para encontrar este pasaje. Ellos ya habían oído acerca de la estancia de Jesús en Galilea y de cuánto todos allí ponderaban sus enseñanzas. ¿Qué les diría a ellos? Él escogió las palabras de Isaías (61:1-2) acerca de uno ungido por el Espíritu, que le anunciaría la buena nueva a los pobres, proclamaría la liberación a los cautivos y todo esto lo haría con gran compasión. Véase otra cita de Isaías (42:6).

Esta misión de tres partes continúa siendo la obra de la Iglesia: predicar el Evangelio, trabajar por la justicia social y llegar a todas las personas con compasión. Al comienzo de su ministerio Jesús anunció, ante los que lo escuchaban, que la profecía de Isaías se había cumplido en él y que podían comprobarlo por las obras que él hacía. 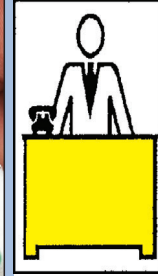
