Dear Parishioners,

I am extremely encouraged by the response of a growing number of parish families who have now pledged a total \$40,240.66 to the Annual Appeal, which is 45.5% of our parish goal of \$104,591.00. ### ***Reflection on Today's Scripture Readings***

By the time Mary Ellen discovered her business manager's thievery, he had charged ten thousand dollars of personal items on the corporate credit card. It was a slap in the face that left her feeling angry, deceived, betrayed. Knowing that Chuck's extended family was in financial trouble only made things harder. Didn't he know he could come to her for help? Rather than press criminal charges, Mary Ellen decided to ask for Chuck's resignation and two hundred dollars per month until the "debt" was paid. She knew she'd made the right decision when Chuck sobbed, "I was wrong. I'm so sorry. I'll pay back every cent."

In our culture such mercy is considered foolish and stupid. From lawsuits to the death penalty, from violence in our schools to gang wars, revenge seems to be our operating principle. Not so in these scriptures. Instead they urge: "Love your enemies," "Be merciful, just as your Father is merciful," "Bear the image of the heavenly one"—Jesus. In short, we are to ask and to do what Jesus would do.

### **Reflexión de las Escrituras de Hoy**

Cuando María Elena descubrió el robo de su gerente administrativo ya él había gastado diez mil dólares de cosas personales en la tarjeta de crédito de la empresa. Fue como una cachetada, que la hizo sentir enojada, engañada y traicionada. Se sintió peor aún al saber que la familia de Carlos atravesaba una situación económica difícil. ¿Acaso no sabía él que hubiera podido pedirle ayuda a ella? En vez de presentar cargos penales contra Carlos, María Elena decidió pedirle su renuncia junto con el compromiso de doscientos dólares mensuales hasta que la "deuda" estuviera saldada. Ella supo que había hecho una buena decisión cuando Carlos le dijo entre sollozos: "Lo que hice estuvo mal y estoy arrepentido. Devolveré todo el dinero".

En nuestra cultura esa clase de misericordia se considera algo insensato y estúpido. Desde las demandas judiciales hasta la pena capital, la violencia en nuestras escuelas hasta las guerras entre pandillas, la venganza parece ser el principio operante. No ocurre así en estas lecturas de hoy. Éstas nos urgen así: "Amen a sus enemigos", "sean misericordiosos como su Padre es misericordioso". O sea, revístanse de la imagen de Jesús. ## LOVE AS GOD LOVES

Our Gospel today continues Jesus' Sermon on the Plain, in which we heard Luke's version of the Beatitudes. This week, Jesus gives us new "commandments," telling us how to live and act in the world as his disciples, rooted in the radical love of God for humanity. It reminds us of his later speech about loving one another as he loves us, in other words with a God-like love, the kind we see in today's psalm about God's mercy. How else could we do as Jesus tells us by loving our enemies, which seems impossible, until we remember that God gave us the example of Jesus, who is like God but also like us? David understands this merciful love when he spares the life of his enemy in the first reading. Finally, Paul tells us that we will become like Jesus if we act as he did, as God does. Copyright © J.
